



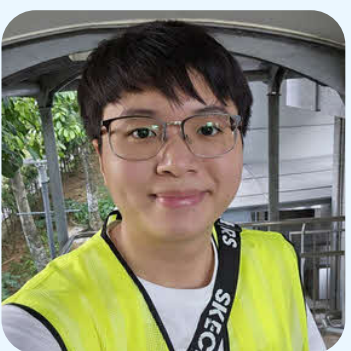

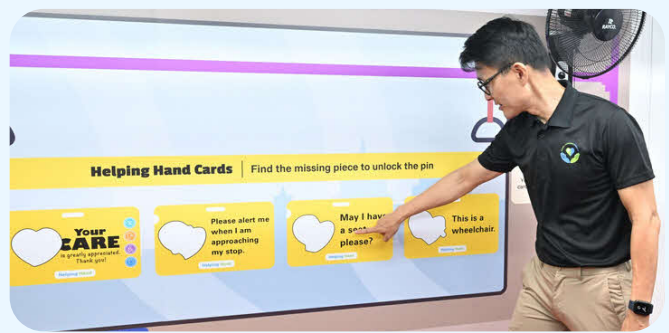


CARING COMMUTER WEEK 2025
