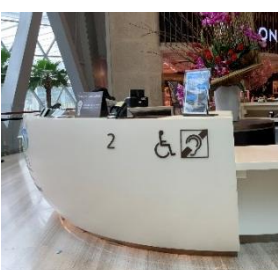

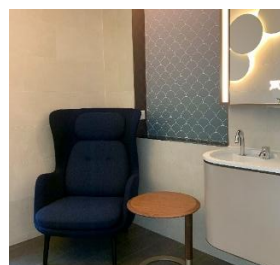

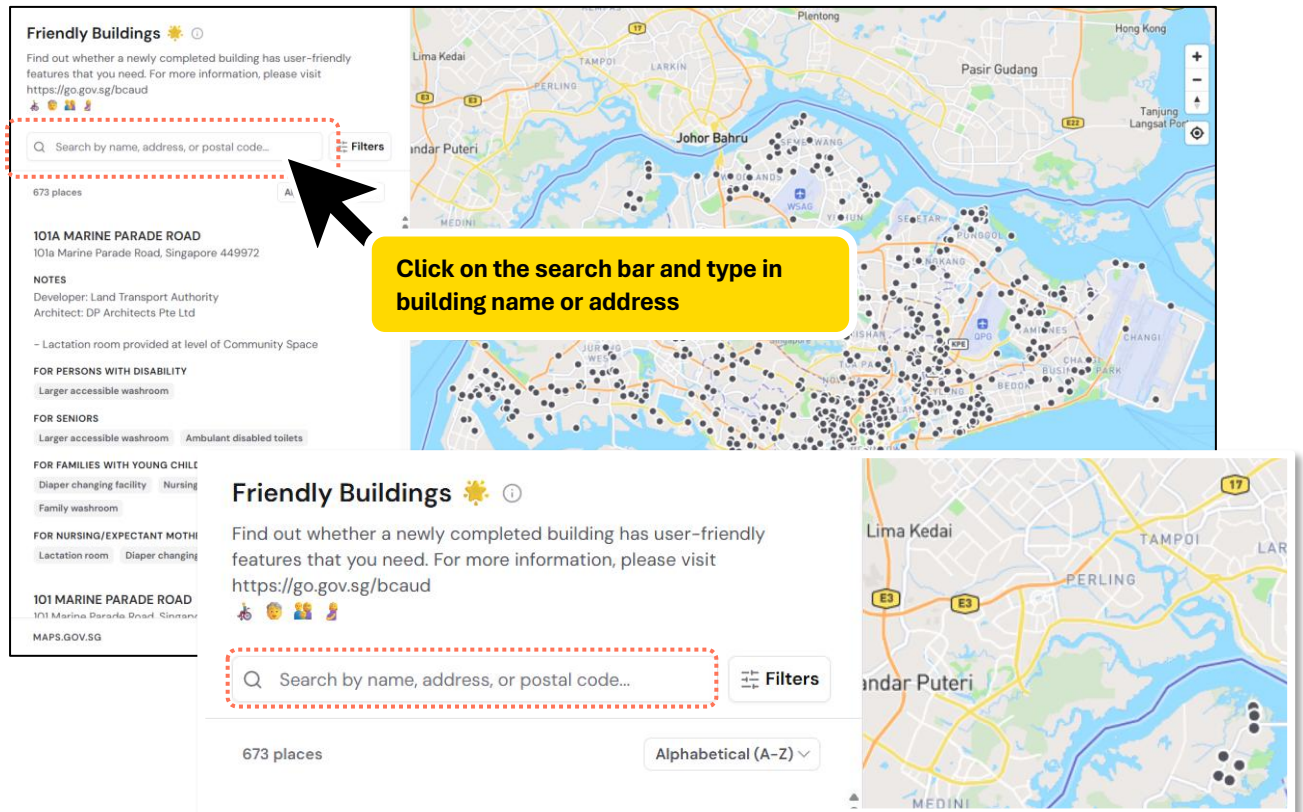

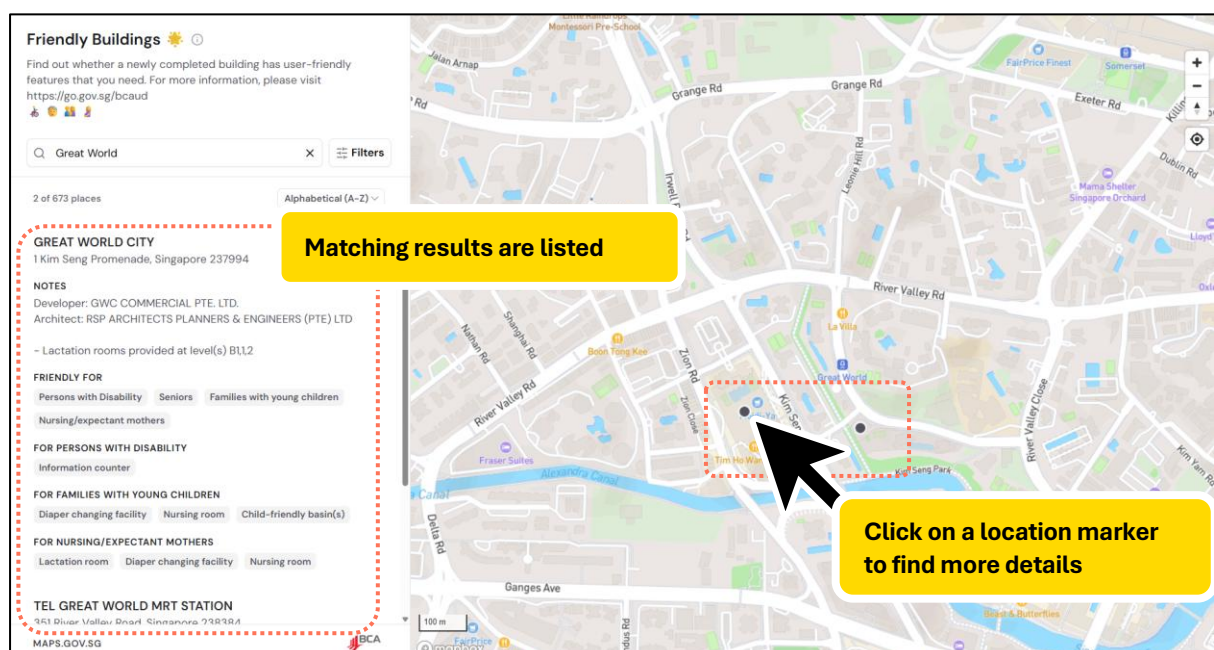

On computers – Search by building name or address

1. Find out more information about a specific building by searching its name or address.



2. Matching results are shown on the left, together with the locations on the map on the right, indicated by circular markers.

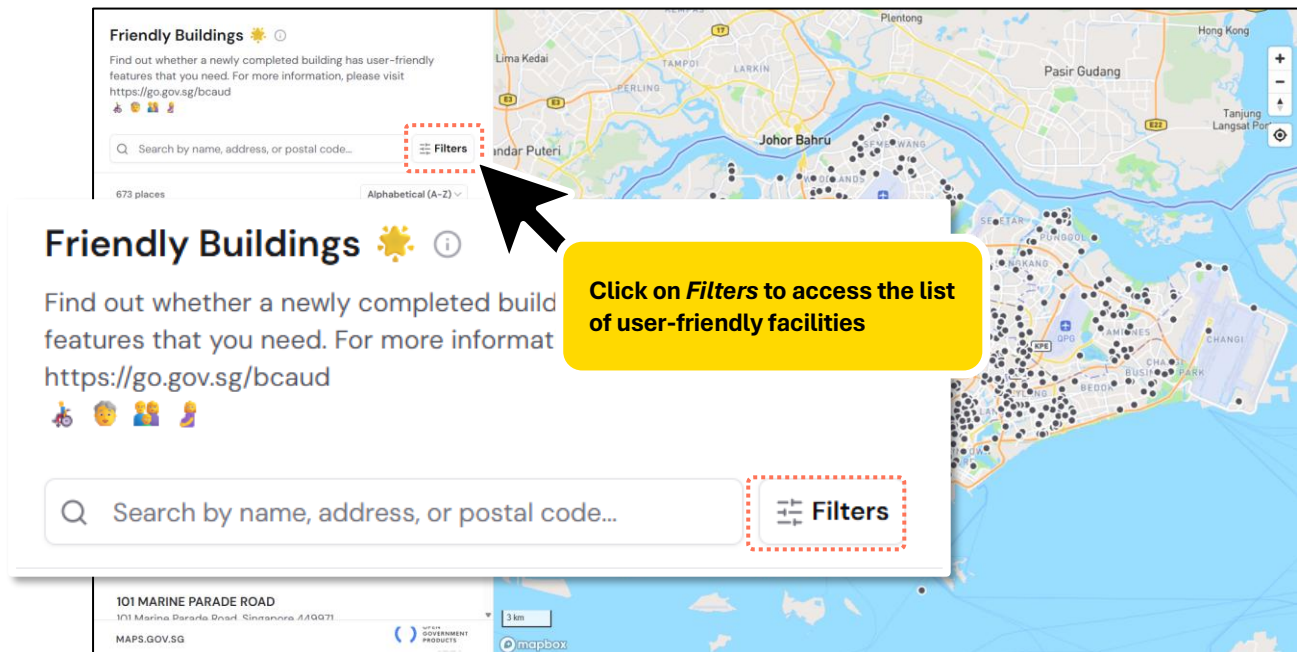

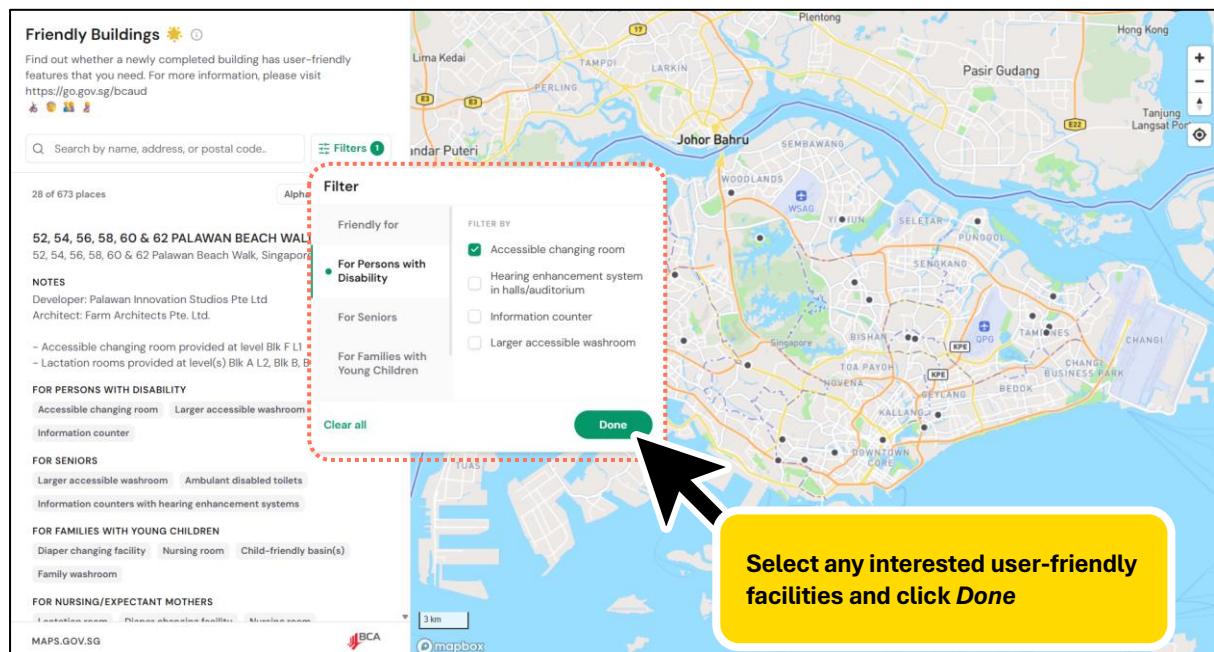

1. Explore by using Filters. Click on *Filters* to access the list of user-friendly facilities.

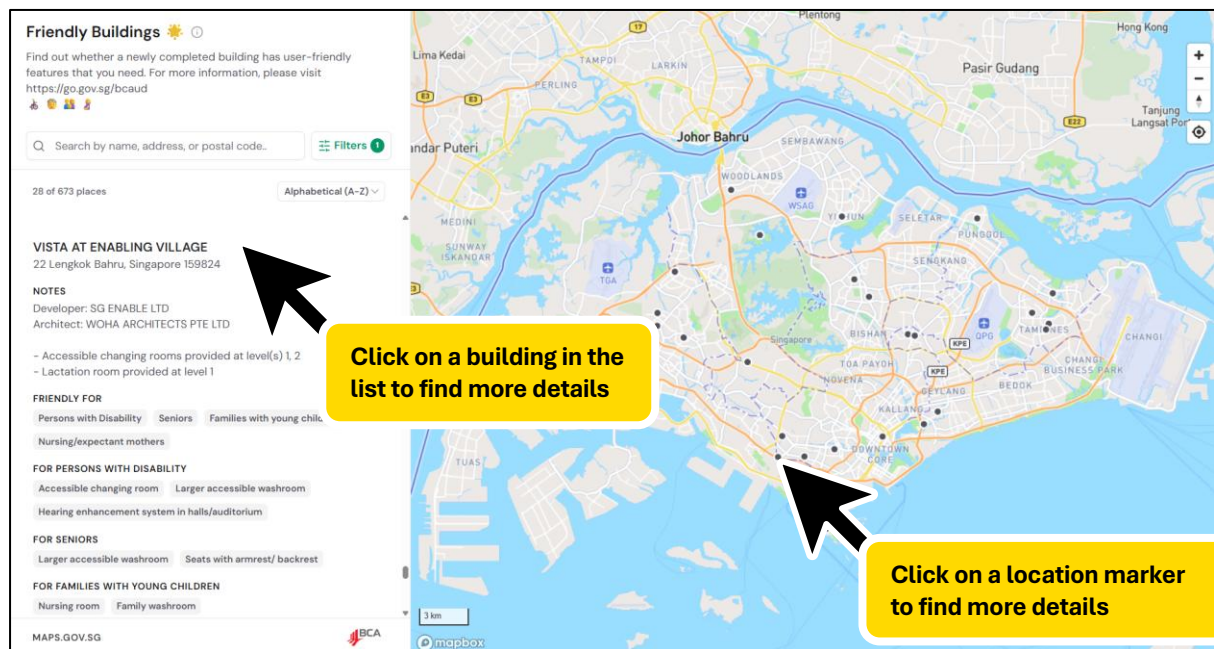


2. Select any interested user-friendly facilities you need and click Done. Buildings with these facilities will show up on the list on the left and the map on the right.

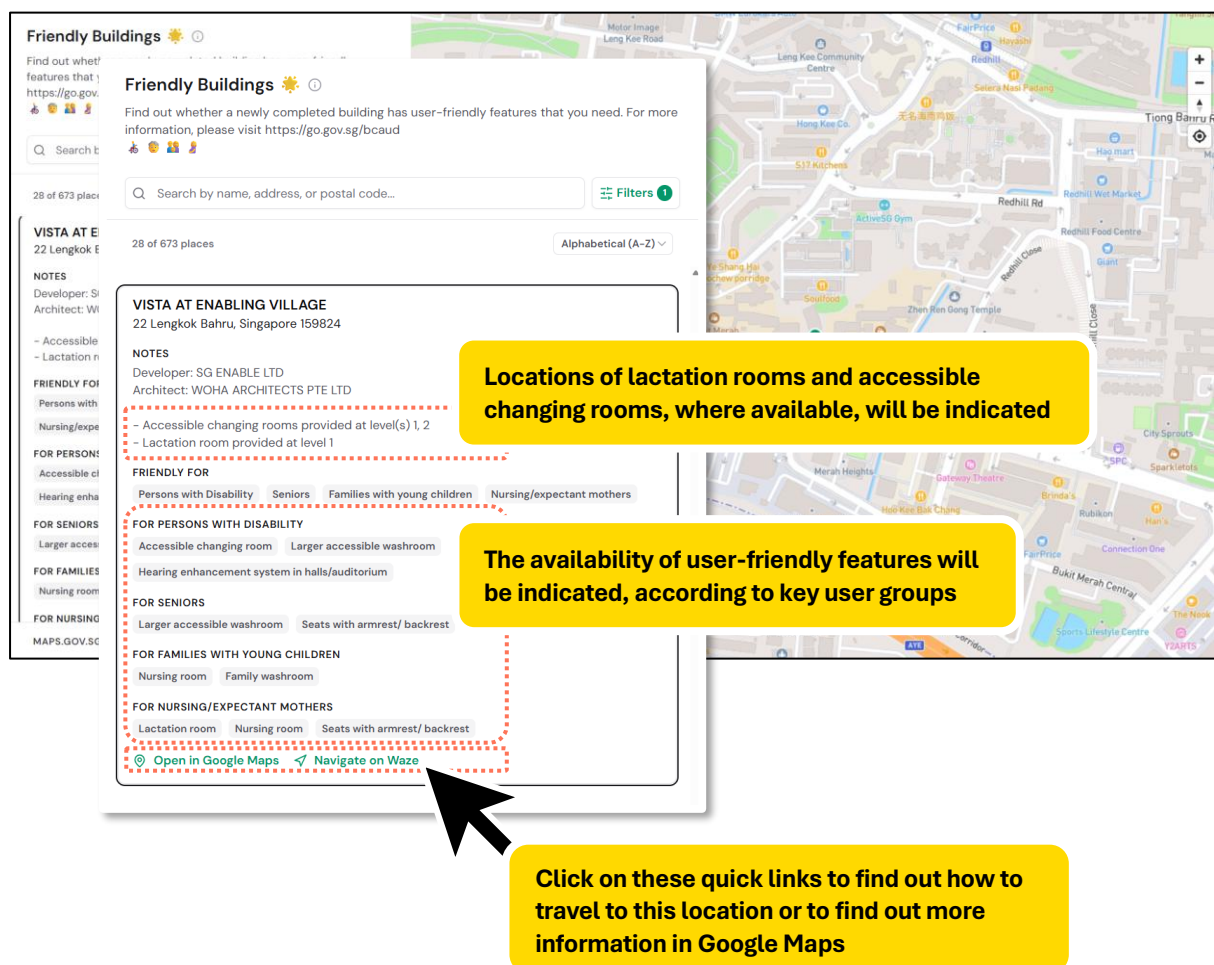


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3. To see more details about the building, scroll through the filtered list, or click on a location marker on the map.



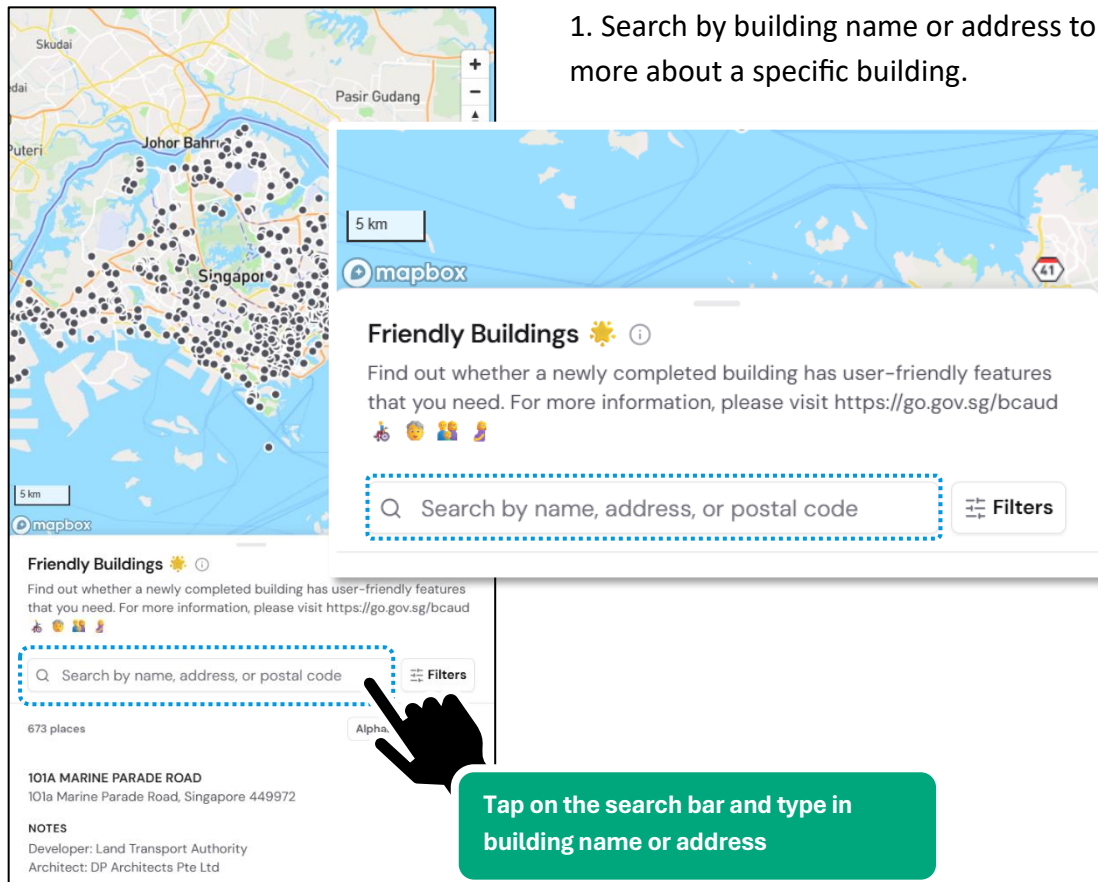

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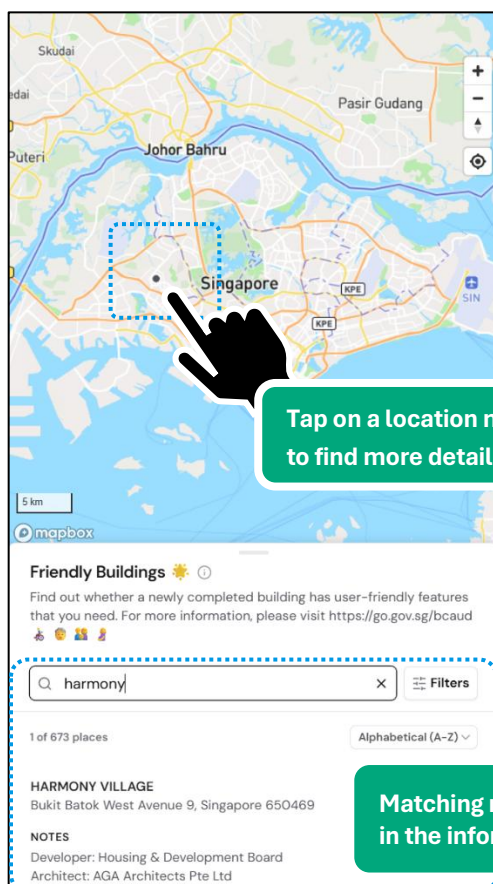
On mobile – Search by building name or address

Tap on the search bar and type in building name or address

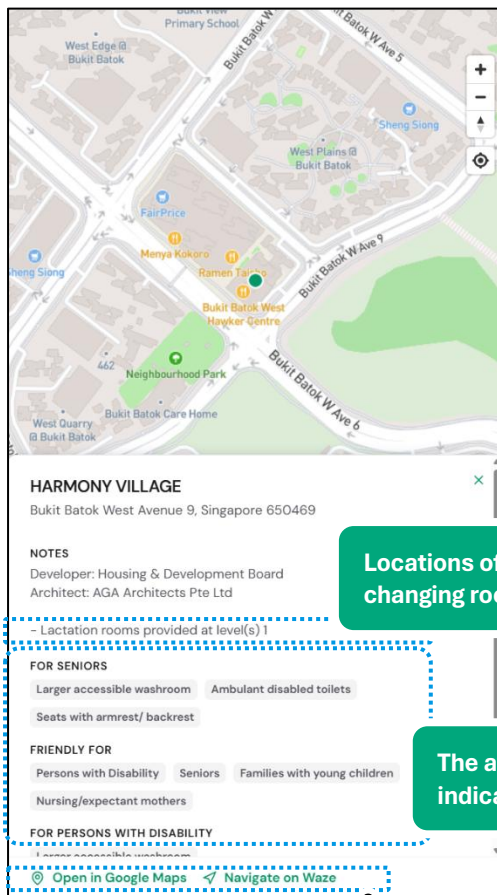
2. Matching results are shown in the list below, together with the locations on the map on the top half, indicated by circular location markers.

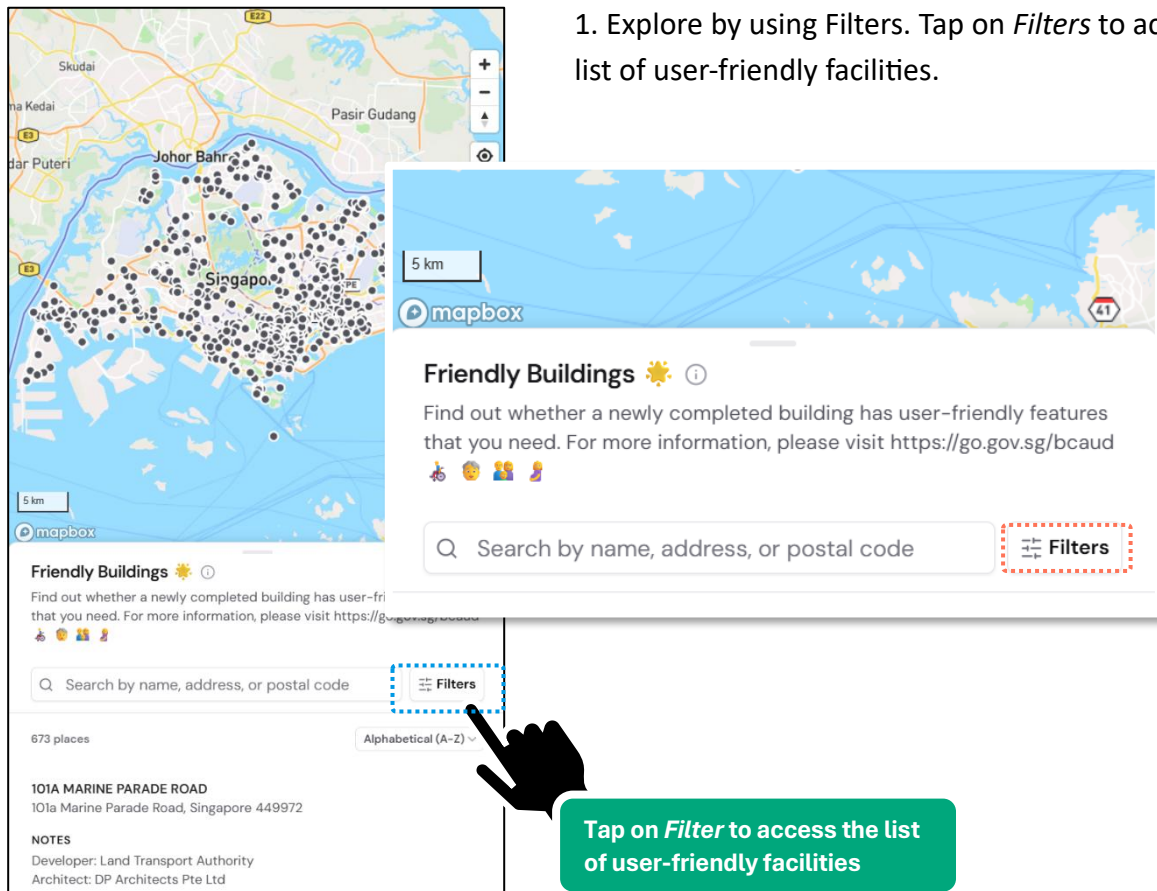

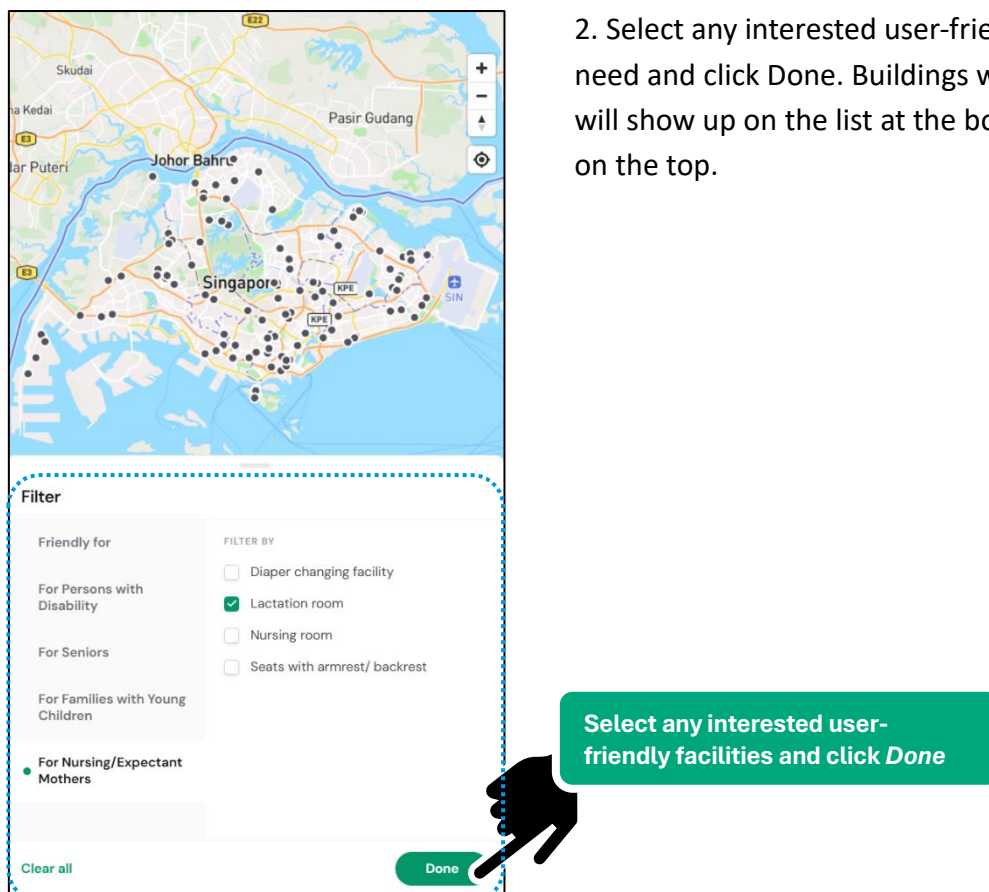
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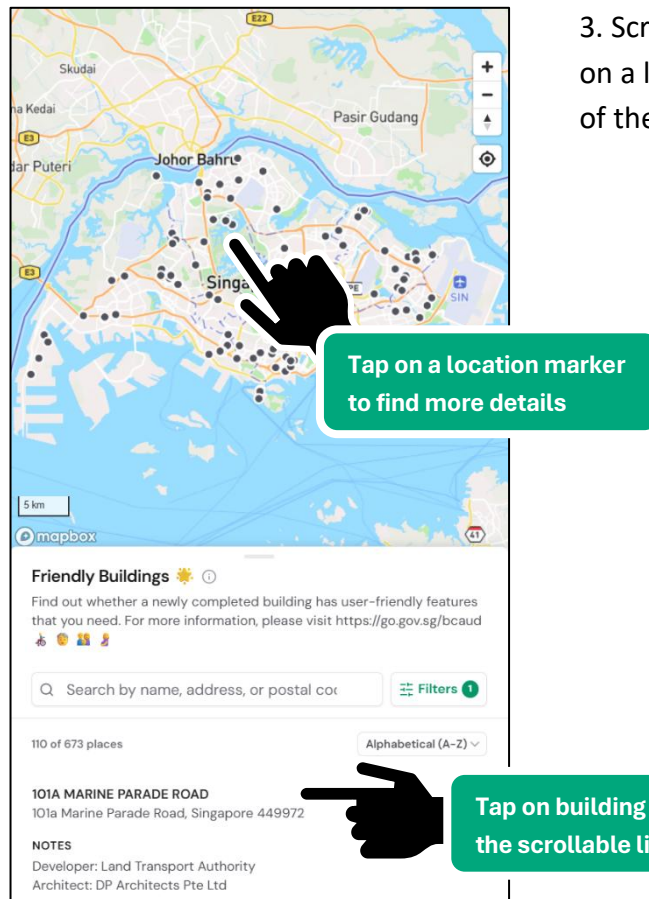
