PRODUCTIVITY SOLUTIONS GRANT (PSG) FOR BUILT ENVIRONMENT

Objective

The circular informs the industry that the enhanced Productivity Solutions Grant (PSG) for the Built Environment (BE) sector is now open for application.

Overview of PSG

2 The Building and Construction Authority (BCA) has launched a new PSG tranche, available from 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2031, to support local BE Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs) in adopting pre-approved solutions aligned with the [Built Environment Industry Digital Plan \(BE IDP\)](#). The BE IDP aims to enhance digital capabilities and improve productivity for all BE SMEs. Since the launch of PSG for the BE sector in 2020, the grant has supported more than 1,100 BE SMEs.

3 In this new PSG tranche, the PSG has been enhanced to help BE SMEs build more advanced capabilities to achieve higher productivity:

- a. Expanded support to advanced equipment such as robotics and automation (R&A)¹ which have shown encouraging productivity gains;
- b. More pre-approved digital solutions in areas such as digital contract management and coordinated regulatory approvals; and
- c. Raised the grant caps to enable longer-term adoption of both digital solutions and advanced equipment.

¹ Such as remote-controlled machineries, inspection and imaging equipment, concrete levelling robots, tile grouting robots, material transporters etc.

Funding Support

4 Eligible local BE SMEs can apply for the PSG, which co-funds up to 50% of the qualifying costs for:

- a. Pre-approved digital solutions with a grant cap of \$50,000 per firm over five (5) years; and
- b. Pre-approved advanced equipment with a grant cap of \$300,000 per firm over five (5) years.

5 SMEs that have previously benefitted from previous PSG tranches are allowed to apply again². SMEs may also submit multiple applications throughout the 5-year period, subject to the grant caps.

Eligibility

- 6 Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria at the point of application³:
- a. Be a business entity registered and operating in Singapore
 - b. Have at least 30% local shareholding; and group annual sales turnover not exceeding S\$100 million or group employment size not exceeding 200 employees
 - c. Have primary and/or secondary business activity in Built Environment sub-sectors according to the Singapore Standard Industrial Classification (SSIC) Code

² Each firm may not apply for the same solution more than once, including any solutions supported under previous tranches of the PSG for the Built Environment.

³ - Firms must not have signed or confirmed a contract, made payment and/or any form of deposits to a supplier, vendor or third party in relation to the purchase/subscription/lease of the solution prior to application submission. - The submission of an application does not automatically entitle the applicant to funding. All applications will be subject to evaluation and approval. Applicants may be required to submit additional supporting documents to facilitate evaluation of the application.
