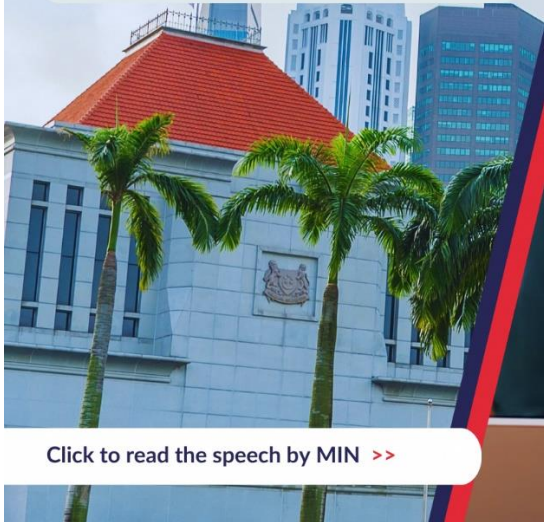

While we enjoy **strong racial and religious harmony** in Singapore, we are **not immune to divisive identity politics.**

Race and religion should **never be exploited for electoral purposes.**

- YR Cares is a new charity formed through the **merger of Yellow Ribbon Fund, NeuGen Fund and Industrial and Services Co-operative Society Limited (ISCOS)**. It will be operational in the first half of 2026.
- YR Cares focuses on **four areas**: reducing reoffending, fostering ex-offenders' contributions to society, supporting families and children to prevent intergenerational offending, and strengthening partnerships for holistic, collaborative care.
- The \$140,000 Lim Tze Peng-Yellow Ribbon Fund STAR Bursary honours the late Mr Lim Tze Peng, whose donated artworks were auctioned to fund **support for ex-offenders pursuing studies in fine arts**.
