

MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS SCHOLARSHIPS

1. The Singapore Police Force Scholarship is one of the most prestigious scholarships awarded by the Public Service Commission. It is awarded to candidates who have shown outstanding leadership qualities, possess impeccable integrity, and have a strong interest in policing work to safeguard our nation.
2. The Public Service Commission (PSC) Scholarship (Engineering) is awarded to outstanding, well-rounded individuals with a passion for engineering. Offered in partnership with the Defence & Security, Information and Communications Technology & Smart Systems, and Infrastructure & Environment clusters, the scholarship develops engineering and technology leaders for the Public Service. The Defence & Security cluster focuses on the design, operation and maintenance of national security infrastructure.
3. The MHA Uniformed Scholarship and the MHA Civilian Scholarship are awarded to well-rounded individuals who demonstrate strong critical thinking, leadership potential and a passion for upholding Singapore's safety and security.
4. MHA Scholarship recipients, whether uniformed or civilian, will begin their leadership journey and pursue meaningful careers with the Home Team. Uniformed Scholarship recipients will serve in one of five Home Team Departments [*the Singapore Police Force (SPF), Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF), Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA), Singapore Prison Service (SPS) and Central Narcotics Bureau (CNB)*]. Civilian Scholarship recipients will serve as Generalists or Specialists across the Ministry Headquarters and Home Team agencies.
5. The HTX Scholarship is awarded to top STEM talents who share the Home Team's mission to keep Singapore safe and secure. Recipients will deepen their expertise in science and technology and join the HTX to apply their skills to enhance the Home Team's operational capabilities.
