

Annex: Singapore's Pledges at the Global Fraud Summit 2026

Singapore reaffirms its commitment to strengthening international cooperation against scams. Recognising that scam syndicates operate across borders and exploit jurisdictional gaps, Singapore pledges to:

- 1. Strengthen transnational enforcement to disrupt and dismantle scam syndicates;**
- 2. Enhance cross-border asset recovery to deny syndicates of criminal proceeds; and**
- 3. Collaborate with industry partners, including online platforms, to raise baseline anti-scam safeguards, and enhance information sharing to detect and disrupt scam-related enablers expeditiously.**

Singapore stands ready to partner governments, international organisations and industry stakeholders to close the gaps that scammers exploit, and build a more coordinated and resilient global response to fraud.
