

## Annex A – Examples on Acts of Purposeful Endangerment

| S/N | Examples on Act of Purposeful Endangerment   |

| 1   | <p>A is driving a motor car on a road. B is driving in another motor car in front of A. A manoeuvres his car in front of B's car and brakes suddenly.</p> <p>A does so for the purpose of endangering B's personal safety. B loses control of his car and crashes into C who was riding a motorcycle. Both B and C die as a result.</p> <p>A is guilty of offences of purposeful endangerment in respect of both B and C.</p>        |
| 2   | <p>A is driving a motor car on a road. B is riding a motorcycle in front of A. A drives closely behind B and presses his car horn several times.</p> <p>This endangers B's personal safety. He does so for the purpose of endangering B's personal safety. A loses control of his car and collides with the back of B's motorcycle. B crashes and dies as a result.</p> <p>A is guilty of an offence of purposeful endangerment.</p> |
| 3   | <p>A is driving a motor car on a road. B is riding a motorcycle. Both parties start racing with one another. A swerves into B's lane for the purpose of endangering B's personal safety.</p> <p>This endangers B's personal safety. B collides into A's vehicle. B is thrown off his motorcycle and dies as a result.</p> <p>A is guilty of an offence of purposeful endangerment.</p>   |
