No.	Date issued	Falsehoods communicated on each of TOC's alternate website and Heidoh's website
1.	26 Mar 2026	<p>1) The Coordinating Minister for National Security and Minister for Home Affairs deliberately chose to give incomplete answers to the Parliamentary Questions on the two Singaporeans who allegedly served in the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) during the Gaza conflict.</p> <p>2) Apart from the information in the Declassified United Kingdom article, the Government had information to act on, including identifying information of the two Singaporeans who allegedly served in the IDF during the Gaza conflict, as evidenced from its formal request to Israel.</p> <p>3) The Government is able to identify the two Singaporeans who have allegedly served in the IDF during the Gaza conflict but has chosen not to identify them.</p> <p>4) The Government has deliberately chosen not to take action under the Internal Security Act 1960 against the two Singaporeans who have allegedly served in the IDF during the Gaza conflict in order to preserve diplomatic relations with Israel.</p> <p>5) The Government did not issue directions under POFMA in respect of the source which stated that two Singaporeans had served in the IDF during the Gaza conflict because this statement was true.</p> <p>6) The Government has decided not to use Section 125 of the Penal Code 1871 against the two Singaporeans who have allegedly served in the IDF during the Gaza conflict, because of Singapore's cordial relations and longstanding defence and intelligence ties with Israel.</p> <p>Press Release: pofmaoffice.gov.sg/files/media-releases/pofma_pr_mha_26Mar2026.pdf</p>

2.	23 Mar 2026	<p>1) Attorney-General (AG) Lucien Wong (AG Wong) has not recused himself from acting on matters pertaining to the compulsory acquisition of 38 Oxley Road.</p> <p>2) During the Committee of Supply debate on 2 March 2026, Ms Sylvia Lim was not permitted to raise any follow-up questions on the AG's re-appointment process.</p> <p>3) The Constitution provides for the AG to retire at age 60 without any qualification or proviso, but the Prime Minister has appointed AG Wong until he is 75.</p> <p>Press Release: pofmaoffice.gov.sg/files/media-releases/pofma_pr_mlaw_23Mar2026.pdf</p>
