

Entrance Test Information for Academic Year 2026 Intake

General Information

- The harmonised Entrance Test(s) are jointly organised by the five Polytechnics in Singapore. Only shortlisted applicants will be invited to sit for the Entrance Test(s) for English and/or Mathematics and/or Science to assess their suitability in the courses applied. Shortlisted applicants will receive the email invitation for Entrance Test(s) by **December 2025**.
- Shortlisted applicants are required to choose **ONE** Polytechnic as their Entrance Test(s) administrator. The Entrance Test(s) for all subjects will be scheduled on the same day with breaks in between each paper. The same test paper for each subject will be used across all Polytechnics, and your test results will be shared with the Polytechnics who have shortlisted you for the Entrance Test(s).
- Shortlisted applicants are required to make Entrance Test(s) fee payment to the Polytechnic that you have chosen as your Entrance Test(s) administrator. Applicants who fail to pay the fees by the deadline will not be allowed to sit for the test. The fees are non-refundable.
- Meeting the Minimum Entry Requirements (MER) is not a guarantee that an applicant will be shortlisted. An invitation to sit for Entrance Test(s) does not guarantee admission to the course.
- More details will be emailed to shortlisted applicants by the Polytechnic you have chosen as your Entrance Test(s) administrator.

- IGCSE (English as a 1st Language)
- International Baccalaureate (IB)
- Malaysia SPM
- Malaysia UEC
- Brunei Cambridge GCE O-Level

Entrance Test Subjects and Course Aggregate Types

Republic Polytechnic courses are categorised into 4 aggregate types. The aggregate type of your course choices will determine the Entrance Test subject(s) that you are required to take. You may refer to the [RP website](#) to check the aggregate type of your course choices.

*Applicants will be exempted from taking the English Entrance Test if they have met any of the following requirements:

- IELTS / IELTS Indicator / IELTS One Skill Retake minimum score of 6 for all individual components (Listening, Reading, Writing & Speaking) and overall band score
- TOEFL Internet-Based Test with minimum score of 78
- Year 12 English Language subject minimum score of 70% from any of these native English-speaking countries: USA, Canada, Australia & New Zealand.

Note: Applicants may choose to include IELTS/TOEFL in their application if they wish to be exempted from taking English Entrance Test
