

ELIGIBILITY

Patients who:

- Are clinically stable
- Are not anticipated to require intensive hospital care
- Are independent or have adequate caregiving support at home
- Are able to medicate independently
- Have telecommunication access (i.e. stable internet connection at home)

Please consult your doctor to determine your eligibility for this programme.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

From 1 Apr 2024, MIC@HOME is a regular public hospital service entitled to the same financial coverage as a physical inpatient stay.

- **Subsidies** will be aligned to patients' original ward class during conventional inpatient stay. For patients without preceding inpatient stay, Class B2/C subsidy framework will apply.
- **MediShield Life, MediSave and Integrated Shield Plan** coverage are applicable to MIC@HOME.
- MIC@HOME is **eligible for MediFund and other financial assistance schemes** - please speak to our medical social worker for more details.

MOBILE INPATIENT CARE@HOME



WHAT IS MIC@HOME?

Mobile Inpatient Care @ Home (MIC@HOME) is an alternative inpatient care delivery model that offers suitable patients the option of being hospitalised in their own homes, instead of a hospital ward. You will be provided with clinical care by a professional care team including doctors, nurses and pharmacists. The care you receive is similar to that in the hospital.

HOW WILL YOU BE CARED FOR AT HOME?

- 24/7 access to the care team
- Combination of teleconsultations and home visits until fit for discharge
- Alerts sent to care team immediately for abnormal vital signs
- Immediate response by care team to address medical needs if condition deteriorates

BENEFITS OF MIC@HOME

- Improved patient experience
- Reduced risk of adverse events
- Reduced risk of hospital-acquired infections and complications

Cost of MIC@HOME will be similar to or lower than normal hospital ward

1 ADMISSION TO MIC@HOME

- Fulfil MIC@HOME admission criteria
- Counsel patient on the programme
- Arrange logistics (e.g., supplying monitoring devices, installing applications)



2 MIC@HOME

- Round-the-clock access to care team
- Regular teleconsultations and remote patient monitoring
- Simple home procedures / blood tests (if any)



3 DISCHARGE

- Discharge plan (including arrangement of medication delivery and follow-up consultations)
