

Singapore Near Miss Reporting System

See it. Report it. Keep our people safe.

- Joint initiative by the National Maritime Safety at Sea Council (NMSSC) and the Singapore Shipping Association (SSA) that provides a confidential, independent, and impartial platform for online near miss reporting.
- Modelled on CHIRP, an internationally recognised framework for confidential human factors reporting, this initiative gives sea space users (e.g. crew, shore-based personnel and passengers onboard harbour craft, pleasure craft, regional ferries, and ocean-going vessels) a simple, online channel to report near misses without fear of reprisal.
- CHIRP acts as an independent third party, sharing only anonymised data with NMSSC to analyse and distil key learnings for the wider maritime community.
- Every report is a learning opportunity. Your sharing could prevent the next incident.
