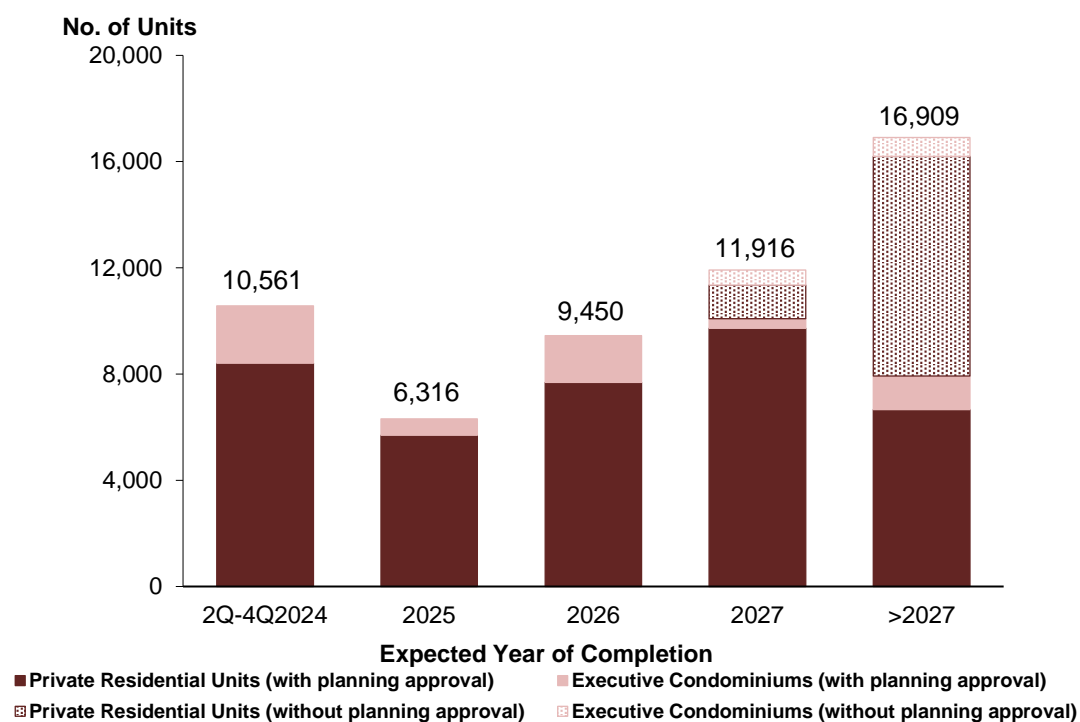


**PIPELINE SUPPLY OF PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL UNITS AND EXECUTIVE  
CONDOMINIUMS BY EXPECTED YEAR OF COMPLETION AS AT 1ST QUARTER 2024**

<sup>1/</sup> As at the end of 1Q2024, there were 21,562 unsold units with planning approval, up from 17,729 units as at the end of 4Q2023. In addition, there is a potential supply of about 10,820 units (including ECs) from Government Land Sales (GLS) sites and awarded en-bloc sale sites that have not been granted planning approval yet. They comprise (a) about 10,790 units (including ECs) from awarded GLS sites and Confirmed List sites that have not been awarded yet; and (b) 30 units from awarded en-bloc sale sites that have not been granted planning approval yet. In total, around 32,380 units (including ECs) could be made available for sale later this year or next year.
