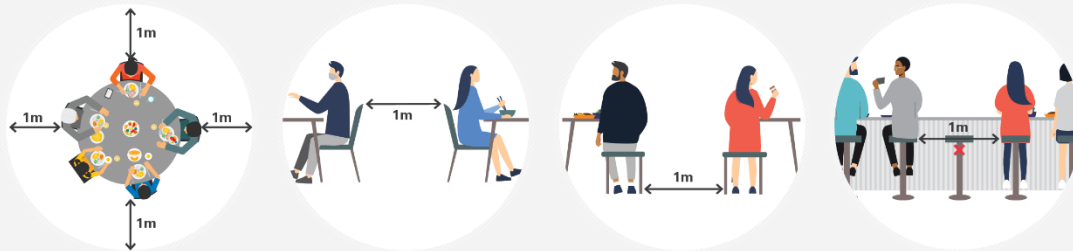


MIND THE GAP

Safe Management Measures at Food & Beverage Establishments (Effective from 12 July 2021)



Limit each table/group to 5 or fewer persons, with at least 1m spacing between groups

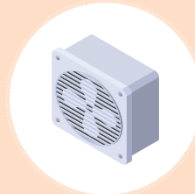
Distance measured between every group (of up to 5 persons) or person, and between the backs or legs of chairs used by diners



From 15 July 2021, all outlet employees at dine-in F&B establishments have to undergo mandatory Fast & Easy Testing (FET) every 14 days



SafeEntry Gateway must be deployed as an additional option for check-in for F&B outlets that need to deploy SafeEntry



Improve ventilation and indoor air quality



Keep masks on at all times, except when eating and drinking



Separate queues for customers and delivery personnel. Clearly mark out queueing areas and space them out by at least 1m



No intermingling between groups



No sale and consumption of alcohol after 10.30pm



No singing, background music or any public entertainment (e.g. live music, radio broadcast, TV/video screenings, karaoke, gaming)

Government agencies will step up enforcement on F&B establishments and take firm action against any breaches.
