

CONCEPTUAL PLANS FOR BUKIT TIMAH TURF CITY

The former Bukit Timah Turf Club site was Singapore's second racecourse from 1933 to 1999, and has been safeguarded for future residential development since Master Plan 1998.

The plans for the area take into consideration the heritage and greenery on site. Selected clusters of former racecourse buildings and structures are intended to be retained and repurposed to create a unique sense of place and identity. Core areas of ecological value will also be retained. The residential neighbourhood will be nestled in a green network of parks, and recreational spaces, providing future residents ample opportunities for communal living, and to explore and bond amidst nature.

Planned as a car-lite district, the neighbourhood is expected to feature distinctive pedestrian streets and attractive public spaces. Residents will also benefit from convenient commuting with access to both the existing Sixth Avenue MRT station along the Downtown Line and the upcoming Cross Island Line Turf City MRT station which is expected to be ready by 2032.
