

## The Modern Bungalow

The Modern Bungalow is characterised by a geometric, free-form approach. The main features are as follows:

- (a) Reinforced concrete construction with structural elements all of reinforced concrete.
- (b) Asymmetrical layout.
- (c) Diamond, circular or square patterned vents above the windows.
- (d) Circular windows and curved corners in some houses.
- (e) Overhanging concrete sun-shading fins.
- (f) Omission of ornamentation.
