

### **Annex: More information on Raffles Place Park**

Raffles Place Park (RPP) is a key public space and urban park located in the heart of the Central Business District (CBD). Constructed as part of the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) works in the 1980s above the underground Raffles Place MRT station, RPP has become a familiar communal space in Raffles Place. As a park located above a busy MRT interchange station with an estimated commuter throughput of 150,000 passengers per day, RPP is easily accessed by visitors, commuters and office workers from surrounding buildings.

Apart from the upcoming enhancement of Raffles Place Park, recent initiatives such as the pedestrianisation of part of Market Street to develop a new park space, provision of Privately-Owned Public Spaces (POPS) at CapitaSpring and Ocean Financial Centre, and the addition of covered linkways connecting CapitaSpring to the covered walkway network along Malacca Street has strengthened Raffles Place's positioning as a car-lite and walkable precinct.
