Islamic Legacy Planning Workgroup (ILPW)

Background

1 In June 2024, MUIS appointed 16 professionals from the community to form the new Islamic Legacy Planning Workgroup (ILPW), marking a significant milestone in raising awareness of Islamic Legacy Planning (ILP) amongst members of the Singapore Muslim community.

2 Chaired by Mr Zhulkarnain Rahim, the ILPW comprises professionals renowned for their expertise in diverse sectors such as wealth management, real estate, legal and religious guidance. These members were carefully selected to spearhead the development of effective ILP materials and programmes to encourage legacy planning, including legacy giving to MUIS entities such as mosques, madrasahs, wakaf and Baitul Mal as well as other charitable organisations, such as Malay-Muslim organisations or Indian Muslim organisations.

3 The ILPW will promote and facilitate ILP for the Singapore Muslim community through various instruments. The key terms of reference of the workgroup include:

- Facilitate development of materials, templates and programmes to raise awareness and facilitate planned giving through legacy planning instruments.
- Engage industry players and community stakeholders including mosques, associations and grassroot leaders to disseminate information and increase participation.
- Establish a network of ambassadors to assist individuals and families in drafting Wasiat, trusts, nominations and other legacy planning instruments.
