TRANSITION OF MUIS HALAL ENDORSEMENT LETTERS TO DIGITAL FORMAT

The Islamic Religious Council of Singapore (MUIS) is pleased to inform that all halal endorsement letters issued by MUIS will now be in digital format. This initiative supports MUIS's ongoing efforts to enhance service delivery and improve operational efficiency through digitalisation.

2 Please note the following:

a. **Official Stamp**

Digital halal endorsement letters are issued without a physical MUIS stamp. This is an intentional feature of the digital format and does not affect the authenticity or validity of the letter.

b. **Validity**

Digital halal endorsement letters issued by MUIS are official documents and carry the same validity as previously issued physical letters.

c. **Verification**

The authenticity of a digital halal endorsement letter can be verified by scanning the QR code embedded on the letter, which links to the corresponding record on the MUIS website.

d. **Signatory**

With effect from 1st August 2026, digital halal endorsement letters will be signed by the Chief Executive of MUIS.
