## WCS Young Leaders Symposium 2026 – Call for Nominations

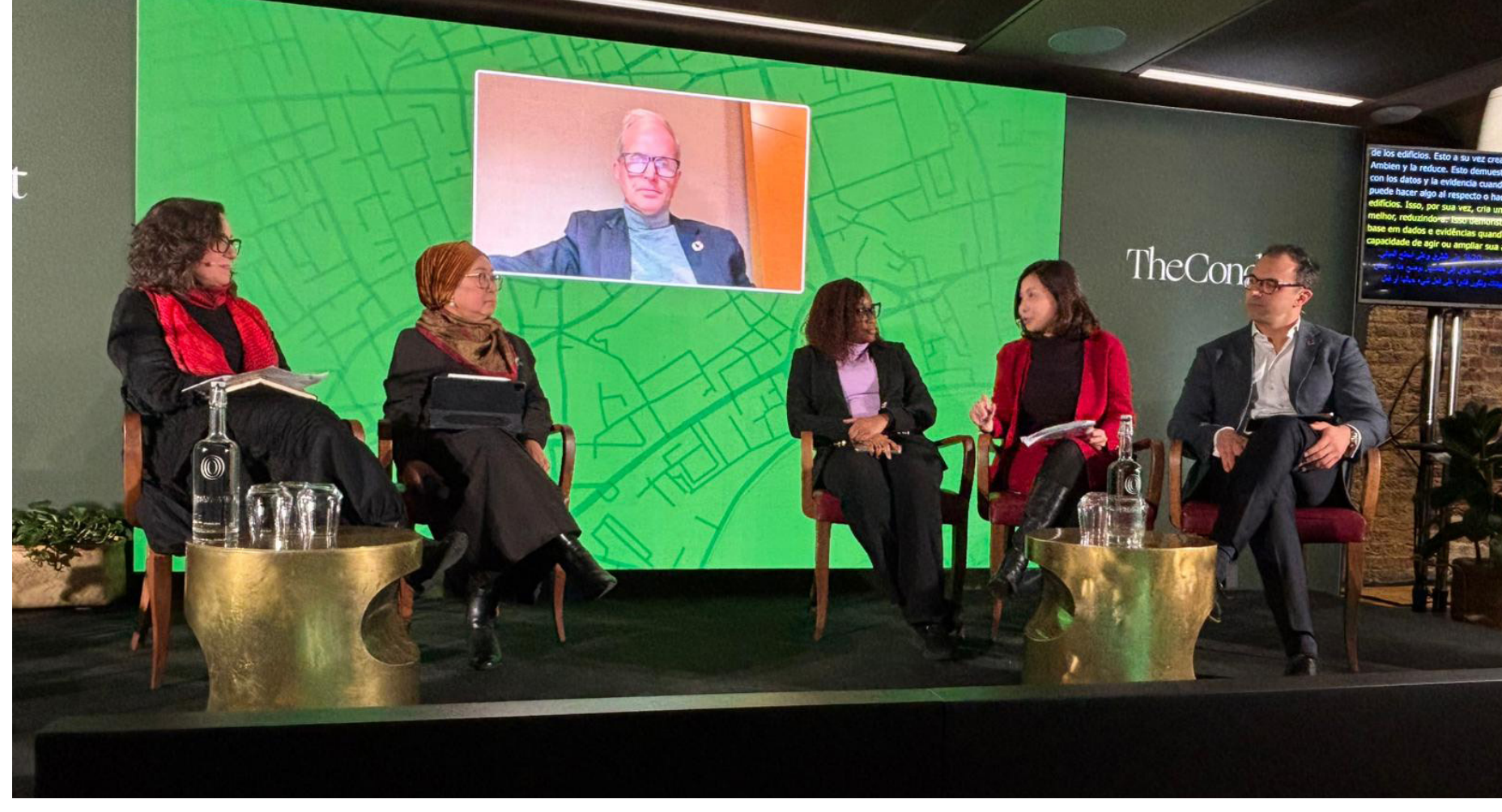

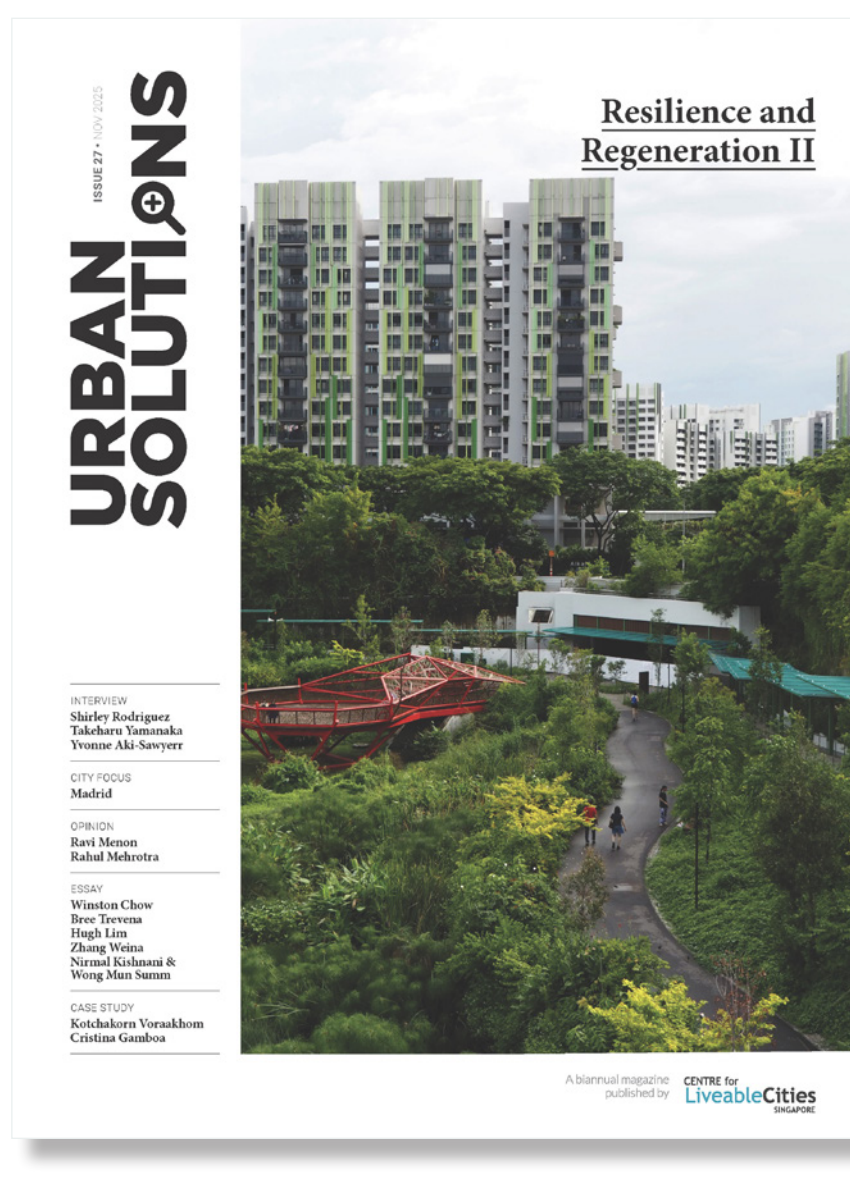
