Describe the online harm which occurred, by answering questions 1 to 4 below.	I am a member of the group named “Food Lovers” on social media networking site Platform ABC. On this group, I regularly discuss with other members about our favourite hawker stalls. On 30 June 2026 starting 11am, a user named “BadUser” made five nasty posts which included my name and profile picture. The posts are time-stamped 11.00am, 11.03am, 11.07am, 11.12am and 11.26am. The user directed profanities at me and said “go and die”, “John deserves to be killed”, “I will hunt John down”, “this John is a liar; please give him a good beating”. These posts are publicly accessible. The URL is https://abc/groups/foodlovers.com. I informed the owner of the group but have not yet received any reply. The posts are still up.
Any other relevant information? (optional)	I do not know who “BadUser” is and have never interacted with that user before. I have also never seen “BadUser” make a post on this group before and do not know why the posts were made.
