Dear Parents,

Re: 2026 Primary 3 Calendar of Events for Term 4

We hope that your child has had a good term break and is looking forward to participate in the activities/ programmes that the school has planned for the Primary 3 level in Term 4.

1. Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

All CCAs are conducted on Tuesdays during school hours. In **Term 4**, CCAs start in **Week 2** on **22 Sep (Tue)**. More information has been provided to students by their CCA teachers.

2. Enrichment and Remedial Programme (ERP)

The Primary 3 ERP is conducted for selected students after school hours from **Term 4 Week 1**. Consent forms have been issued to the selected students by the respective teachers-in-charge before the start of the programme. Details are listed in the table below.

3. Personal Grooming and Attire Check

Marsilians are expected to always be good ambassadors of the school by maintaining a neat and tidy appearance. Having proper attire and grooming also shows readiness for learning. The school will conduct a personal grooming and attire check in **Term 4 Week 6**. 4. PSLE Written Examinations

The PSLE Written Examination will be conducted from **24 Sep (Thu)** to **30 Sep (Wed)**. All Primary 1 and Primary 2 students are required to attend school on these days. **Primary 3 to Primary 5 students** are **not** required to attend school; they will be on Home-based Learning (HBL) and are to complete their assigned work at home on the following dates. They will be assigned tasks by their subject teachers which may include activity books, revision papers and/or SLS assignments. Students should complete their assignments within this period.

5. English Language Fiesta cum Children's Day Celebration

The English Language (EL) Fiesta cum Children's Day celebration will begin with EL Fiesta; focusing on our students' favourite genre, Adventure. This year, the theme 'Treasure Hunt' was chosen to ignite student's interest to delve deeper into stories of hidden secrets and lost jewels. This fortnightly event will include an array of items ranging from our library, SLS and recess activities. Activities include deciphering secret codes, finding lost treasures, solving puzzles and role-plays.

As a climax to EL Fiesta, the school will be having Children's Day Celebration, on the eve of Children's Day, **1 Oct (Thu)**. On this day, no lessons will be conducted. Students will be treated to a day of fun learning through booth activities and concert. Students will be **dismissed at 10.30 am**. Please make the necessary transport and childcare arrangements for your child's early dismissal. The following day, **2 Oct (Fri)**, is a school holiday for Children's Day. **Students will return to school on 5 Oct (Mon)**.

6. PSLE Marking Exercise

The annual PSLE Marking Exercise is scheduled from **12 Oct (Mon) to 14 Oct (Wed)**. Students are **not** required to attend school on these days; they will be on Home-based Learning (HBL) and are to complete their assigned work at home. They will be assigned HBL tasks by their subject teachers which may include activity books, revision papers and/or SLS assignments. Students should complete their assignments within this period, and are encouraged to practise the 3Rs – Read, Revise and Relax.

Selected students will be participating in the Drawing Masterclass programme. Consent form will be issued to these students by the respective teacher-in-charge before the start of the programme.

9. Last Day of School and 2027 Primary 1 Orientation Day

The last day of school for Primary 1 to Primary 5 students is on **18 Nov (Wed)**. Only Primary 6 students and prize winners will need to report to school on **19 Nov (Thu)** for AADmirable 2026. There is no school for all students on **20 Nov (Fri)** as the school will be conducting Primary 1 Orientation for the 2027 cohort.
