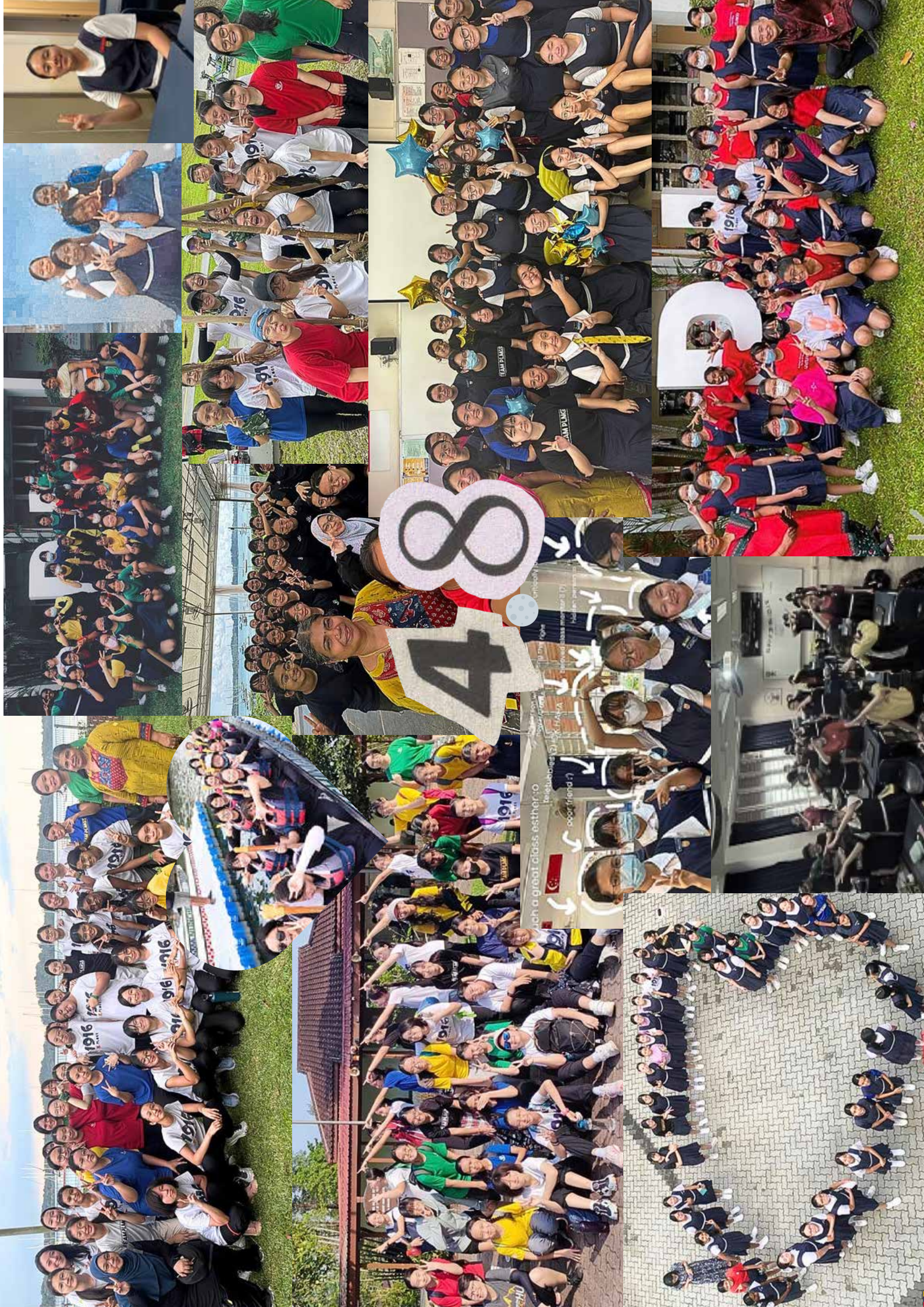


Dear 4.8
