Teachers' Day Celebrations (3 September)

4. QtPS will be celebrating Teachers' Day on Thursday, 3 September. As part of the celebration, students will be dismissed at 10.30 am on Thursday, 3 September. Bus services will be provided for students taking the school bus on that day. This will be the last school day of Term 3.

Teachers' Day School Holiday and Term Break (4 September to 13 September)

6. The Teachers' Day school holiday will be on Friday, 4 September, followed by the Term Break from Saturday, 5 September to Sunday, 13 September. Students will return to school for Term 4 on Monday, 14 September. We would like to take this opportunity to wish all teachers a Happy Teachers' Day, and our QtPS Family a restful term break.

P6 PSLE Listening Comprehension (15 September) and school closure for P1 to P5

7. Our P6 students will be sitting for their PSLE English and Mother Tongue Listening Comprehension Examinations on 15 September. P6 students will be given separate instructions on their reporting time for PSLE Listening Comprehension.

8. As such, P1 to P5 students **should not report to school** on 15 September. There will be no HBL set for students for 15 September.

Pre-PSLE Study Break for P6 Students (21-23 September)

9. Primary 6 students will have a three-day study break from 21 September (Monday) to 23 September (Wednesday), aimed at supporting their well-being and preparation ahead of the PSLE. Primary 6 students do not need to report to school. Subject teachers will arrange virtual consultation sessions with the students. More details will be communicated closer to the dates.

PSLE Written Examinations (24 -30 September) and HBL for P3 to P5

10. The PSLE written papers will be held from Thursday, 24 September to Wednesday, 30 September. P6 students will be given separate instructions on their reporting times and examination procedures.

11. P1 to P2 students will come to school for lessons as per normal.

12. To minimise disruptions to the PSLE examinations, P3 to P5 students will have staggered Home-Based Learning (HBL) on stipulated days during this period. Students will stay at home to complete their HBL work on those days. More details on the HBL will be shared closer to the date. The stipulated days are as follows:
