National Day Celebration (7 August) & Public Holiday (10 August)

6. QtPS will be celebrating Singapore's 61st birthday on Friday, 7 August 2026. Our school-wide celebrations will include a lively mini concert and engaging classroom activities, all centred on this year's National Day theme, "Majulah Singapura, Go Beyond!". As there will be no recess that day, students are encouraged to bring their own snacks. They are also invited to dress in red T-shirts, along with their school shorts or skirts, socks, and shoes.

7. Please note that students will be dismissed earlier than usual, at 10.30 a.m. on Friday, 7 August. Bus services will be provided for students taking the school bus on that day.
