Mid-Year Meet-the-Parents Session (MTPS) on Fri, 29 May

The Mid-Year MTPS is an important event in our school's calendar where:

- a) your child shares his/her learning and experience in school,
- b) our teachers update you about your child's progress in his/her learning and development, and
- c) we discuss strategies to support your child to reach his/her potential.

We will be conducting our **face-to-face MTPS** in school on **29 May**. For parents who are unable to turn up for the sessions on this day, please make alternative arrangements with the Form Teachers. As our teachers will be engaging all parents, we seek your understanding to keep the conversation to 15 minutes with the Form Teachers. More information regarding the Mid-Year MTPS and booking process will be shared with you in May.

Safety Advisory and Improvement Works

As part of our ongoing commitment to provide a safe and conducive environment for our students, the school is currently undertaking a series of improvement works. At the same time, there are external construction projects taking place in the vicinity of the school. We would like to seek parents' support in reminding students to remain vigilant, especially when leaving school each day.

The following improvement works are ongoing or have been scheduled:

- a) Installation of automatic roller shutters (ongoing).
- b) Installation of new bi-fold doors at the Multi-Purpose Hall (MPH) (ongoing).
- c) Construction of a new footpath near the fishpond between Blocks B and C (ongoing).
- d) Upgrading of Light-Emitting Diode (LED) lighting and Direct Current (DC) fans (commencing April 2026).
- e) Construction of lifts at Block E and the Indoor Sports Hall (ISH) (commencing April 2026).
- f) Design and development of a sensory garden and green spaces (planning phase).

The following external works are also taking place nearby:

- a) HDB BTO High Linkway construction (future Bedok South Blossoms BTO entrance) along Bedok South Avenue 3 (9 March to 26 June 2026)
- b) LTA Round Island Cycling Path construction and associated encroachment works (commencing 4 May 2026)

With these ongoing developments, students are reminded to be especially careful when navigating areas around the school, particularly the cycling path outside the school. **For their safety, students should not be using mobile devices or listening to music through earphones while walking, as these may reduce their awareness of their surroundings.**

We appreciate parents' support in reinforcing these safety practices and encouraging students to stay alert, use designated pathways, and exercise caution at all times.

Fostering Responsibility and Independence in Students

We observe that some parents have been dropping off homework and personal items for their children during school hours. While we understand the intent to support your child, we believe that developing responsibility is an important life skill.

As highlighted by former Education Minister Chan Chun Sing, while parents naturally wish to support their children, continually stepping in to resolve minor issues or oversights may limit opportunities for children to learn independence and accountability. Allowing students to manage the consequences of forgetting items helps them build resilience, organisational habits, and problem-solving skills.
