Primary 1 Term 4 Level Matters

Welcome back! We hope your child had a restful week and is ready for another exciting term. Here is an update of the activities happening in Term 4.

Programme for Active Learning (PAL)

Students will explore the realm of Performing Arts once again, this time focusing on Drama. This module aims to provide students with authentic opportunities to learn, experience and apply the five Social and Emotional (SE) competencies: self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship management and responsible decision-making.

Through these learning experiences, students will develop their ability to apply these SE competencies in their daily lives, supporting their overall personal growth and development.

Physical Education, Art, and Music (PAM)

For Physical Education, students will engage in a variety of activities aimed at developing physical skills and promoting healthy habits. In Gymnastics, students will learn to perform a sequence involving two different movements with smooth transitions, enhancing their coordination and control. They will also continue to develop key movement skills through Games and Sports activities.

In addition, students will learn about physical health and safety, including the components of a balanced diet, the importance of eating fruits and vegetables, and how to make healthier choices when selecting drinks and snacks. These lessons aim to support students' physical development while encouraging healthy habits from a young age.

For Art, students will be introduced to drawing as a visual language and a means of personal expression. Through the lessons, students will develop their drawing skills while building confidence and finding joy in expressing their ideas creatively.

For Music, students will explore simple rhythms and create their own rhythmic ostinatos using body percussion to accompany a song. They will also learn about musical phrases and demonstrate their understanding by adapting their actions or movements in response to different parts of a song.

Students will be going on a learning journey to Cold Storage Jelita. More details will be shared by the form teachers via Parents Gateway closer to the date.
