Dear Parents/Guardians,

Following a fast-paced and eventful Term 3, our Secondary 4 and 5 students are now entering the final lap of their secondary school journey. As we step into Term 4, let us rally around them to provide the support, guidance, and encouragement as they face their upcoming national examinations.

Critical National Examination Milestones

To help you guide your child/ward in planning their final revision schedules, please take note of the upcoming examination dates. As individual examination schedules vary, we ask that you closely review the specific dates and timings provided on your child/ward's official entry proof.

GCE N-Level

- **GCE N-Level Written Examinations:** Written papers will be conducted in two blocks: Block 1 from **14 to 24 September 2026** and Block 2 from **5 to 13 October 2026**.
- **GCE N-Level Listening Comprehension Examination (English and Mother Tongue):** This will take place from **15 September to 16 September 2026**.

GCE O-Level

- **GCE O-Level MTLB Oral Examination:** This will be held on **23 September 2026**.
- **GCE O-Level Science Practical Examinations:** These practical examinations will take place from **30 September 2026 to 13 October 2026**.
- **GCE O-Level Listening Comprehension Examination:** This will be held on **15 October 2026**.
- **GCE O-Level Written Examinations:** The main block of written papers will span from **19 October to 10 November 2026**.

Key Revision and Study Leave Arrangements

To ensure our students are prepared for their remaining papers, please take note of the following academic schedules:

- **GCE N-Level Candidates:** In the period between the N-Level Block 1 and Block 2 examinations (**28 September to 2 October 2026**), all Secondary 4 Normal students are required to return to school for structured revision lessons. This dedicated time will be used by teachers to consolidate learning, address gaps, and run targeted practice sessions to ensure students maintain their momentum for their remaining papers. In preparation for these lessons, students should refer to Edupage for their lesson timetable.





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- **GCE O-Level Candidates (Study Leave):** To provide our O-Level candidates with time for independent revision and consolidation, the school has arranged a period of Study Leave from **7 October to 16 October 2026**. During this time, students are expected to revise productively at home and are only required to report to school for their scheduled examinations. Should they require academic assistance, they are highly encouraged to book consultation slots with their respective subject teachers.

Celebrating Milestones: Graduation Ceremony and Prom

As your child/ward comes to the end of their secondary school journey, we also want to honor the milestones that marked their time at Loyang View:

- **Graduation Ceremony (Friday, 25 September 2026):** We are delighted to warmly invite parents and guardians to join us in celebrating our students' achievements during this milestone event. Please refer to the Graduation Ceremony letter published on Parents Gateway on 3 Aug for more information about the event.
- **Secondary 4 and 5 Prom (Wednesday, 11 November 2026):** Following the completion of their examinations, this special evening will serve as an opportunity for the cohort to gather, celebrate the end of their secondary school journey, and create lasting memories with their peers and teachers.
