UPDATES ON EVENTS IN TERM 2 2026

The school strongly recommends that overseas travel only take place during student protected time, so that your teen can continue to participate in scheduled school activities supporting holistic development (e.g. CCA).

B. S4/5 Small Group Academic Consultations – StARS

- Our Structured Academic Review and Support programme (StARs) will start in **Term 2 Week 1 to Term 3 Week 10**. This small group academic consultation programme aims to support students in developing stronger mastery in specific subjects, as well as to stretch students who have demonstrated proficiency in their subjects.
- These consultations will take place on Mondays, Tuesdays (after CCA Stand Down in Term 2 Week 6 onwards), Thursdays and Fridays. Consultations do not occur on Wednesday afternoons as they serve as rest days for our students. This allows students to better manage their time between CCA practices, competitions, studies and rest. Consultations will end by 5.00pm, to give students time to rest and prepare for the next school day.
- Your teen may be attending consultations more than once a week for various subjects and will be informed via their subject teachers. **Attendance is required for these selected students who will be informed by their subject teachers.** Do encourage your teen to attend the consultations diligently and make full use of these learning opportunities.
- Please refer to the attached **Annex** for the detailed schedule.

C. Health Matters and Temperature Taking Exercise

- The school continues to prioritise student health and remains vigilant in checking in on student well-being. Your support is also crucial towards keeping Bowen a safe environment for students. Please remind your teen to practice good personal hygiene (e.g. washing/sanitising hands) and exercise personal and social responsibility. While mask-wearing is no longer required in a school setting, it remains an effective way to minimise the risk of infectious disease transmission. Students who prefer wearing masks are welcome to continue doing so.
- If your teen is unwell, please ensure he/she stays at home and seeks medical attention if necessary. Do also inform his/her Form Teachers (FTs). If your teen is recovering from respiratory-related illness, please encourage him/her to exercise social responsibility (e.g. by wearing a mask, minimising social interactions). Social responsibility will be crucial in preventing any infectious disease outbreak in schools. In the event your teen has to miss school, his/her learning will be supported. FTs will assign a buddy to update your teen on lessons and collect his/her learning materials. Please encourage your teen to be proactive in finding out on what he/she has missed from his/her buddy.
- Please note that all schools will be carrying out a temperature-taking exercise on **Wed 1 Apr**. We would appreciate it if you could remind your teen to bring a working thermometer on **Tue 31 Mar** for a

check, and for use on **Wed 1 Apr**. Do also encourage your teen to continue bringing a thermometer to school so that he/she can monitor his/her health whenever necessary.

D. Nanyang Polytechnic Course Advising Workshop

10. The workshop will be held at Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP) on **Mon 6 Apr**, to provide students with invaluable insights into academic and student life at the polytechnic as well as an overview of the evolving industry landscape in Singapore. Participants will have the opportunity to dialogue with polytechnic lecturers, learn more about the courses offered and gain a better understanding of various career pathways.
11. The programme will run from 3.00 to 5.30pm. Students will be dismissed from NYP directly at about 5.30pm. One-way transport will be provided for students from school. Attendance is compulsory for classes Sec 4TSPARK & 5E.

E. Student Leaders Investiture

12. Our Student Leaders Appointment Ceremony will take place on **Mon 27 Apr** during school hours. This is an important annual event where the school witnesses the handover between the current and the next Student Leaders Executive Committee. The event will also celebrate the investiture of new Student Councillors, Class Leaders, CCA Leaders, Tech Champions and Peer Support Leaders, who as role models, will lead and serve the school and their fellow Bowenians to the best of their abilities. Parents/guardians of incoming Student Leaders Executive Committee members will receive an invitation to join us for the ceremony via Parents Gateway.

F. Celebrating Students' Achievements: 44th Speech and Prize Presentation Day

13. Our 44th Speech and Prize Presentation Day will be held on **Fri 15 May** from **4.00pm to 6.30pm** in the school hall. It is a key school event where we celebrate our students' academic and co-curricular successes. Prize recipients will need to report to the respective school venues by **3.00pm** (More details will be given nearer to the date). Parents/guardians of all 2025 Sec 1 to 3 Prize Recipients will be notified via Parents Gateway.
14. Please note that lessons will carry on as usual from 7.30am to 12.30pm. However, there will be no CCA that afternoon. If your teen is involved in the Speech and Prize Presentation Day (e.g. emcees, AV crew, CCA performers etc.), you will be informed via Parents Gateway.

G. Mother Tongue Language Intensive Programme

15. The GCE O-Level Mother Tongue Language (MTL) written examinations will take place on **Tue 2 Jun**. To help students prepare for the exams, our MTL department will be conducting an Intensive Revision Programme from **Fri 22 May to Tue 26 May**. The programme will be conducted during curriculum time as well as in the afternoons. Students will be dismissed by 5.00pm during this period.
16. Students who are not sitting for the GCE O-Level MTL Examinations are still required to report to school. The school has arranged a customised curriculum for these students, which will be supported by their subject teachers. The schedule will be given to students after their Term Assessment 2.

H. June Extended Curriculum (JEC)

17. To provide additional academic support for our graduating cohort in their crucial year, selected Sec 4/5 students are required to attend JEC from **Wed 3 Jun to Mon 8 Jun**. Teachers will use the time to help them gear up for the national examinations and final coursework submissions (where applicable). The schedule for the extended curriculum will be given to students by Term 2 Week 10.
18. Please note that attendance is compulsory for the selected Sec 4/5 students offering subjects mainly at O-Level and N(A)-Level. Sec 4 students offering mainly N(T) subjects may be required to attend consultations by their subject teachers during this period. We seek your understanding and cooperation to refrain from making overseas travel plans during this period, and to monitor your teen's attendance for the extended curriculum.

I. Road Safety Matters

19. We would like to reinforce the need for all students to adhere to traffic regulations when travelling to and from school. We seek parents/guardians' support to remind our students to be aware of their surroundings and follow safe practices such as crossing public roads at correct designated areas. We would also like to take this opportunity to sincerely appeal to all parents/guardians who drive to observe the speed limit, practice safe driving and show graciousness to our staff on duty when in a school zone, for the safety and well-being of our students, staff and other stakeholders.
