Teachers' Day Celebrations

Students should bring along a small bag with a water bottle, a story book, stationery and some healthy dry snacks. Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward to return home if she is not taking the school bus.

The following day (Teachers' Day on Friday, 4 September 2026) is a school holiday. The General Office will be closed at 5.00pm on 4 September 2026.

Children's Day Celebration

The school will celebrate Children's Day on Thursday, 1 October 2026. We will be having activities and picnic in the class and ending the day with a concert.

All students are to report to school by 7.25am and will be dismissed at 10.30am.

We will implement the same arrangement as Teachers' Day mentioned above, hence please refer to the instructions for staggered dismissal timings, snack time and transport arrangements.

The following day (Children's Day on Friday, 2 October 2026) is a school holiday. The General Office will be closed at 5.00pm on 2 October 2026.

Travel Declaration for School Holidays

If your child/ward is travelling during the September school holidays, please make the necessary declaration for her via Parents Gateway (PG) under Services -> Declare Travels. If there is a need to amend the travel plan, you can do so via the same module in PG. If your child/ward is not travelling during the holidays or the long weekends, no action is required.

PSLE Examination Dates

1. PSLE Listening Comprehension (15 September 2026)

The PSLE Listening Comprehension examinations for Primary 6 students will take place on the date stated above. **There will be no school for P1 - P5 students that day.**

To ensure a safe and conducive environment for the examination, the school will not admit visitors on these days. This includes parents, caregivers and P1 to P5 students for non-emergency cases, e.g. collection of homework or retrieval of lost items. Please remind your child/ward to take home whatever she needs. A few canteen stalls will be open on the day of the PSLE Listening Comprehension (i.e. 15 September 2026) to cater to the Primary 6 students. However, the bookshop and dental clinic will be closed.

2. PSLE Written Papers (24 - 30 September 2026)

The PSLE Written examinations for Primary 6 students will take place from 24 to 30 September 2026. P6 students are dismissed at the end of each paper. Here are the reporting arrangements for P1 to P5 students:

Level	Arrangement
P1	Students report to school as per normal from 24 to 30 September 2026.
P2	Students report to school as per normal from 24 to 30 September 2026.
P3	Students do not report to school from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. Instead, they will have Home-Based Learning from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. There are no online face-to-face lessons but students will be assigned work to do independent study at home. Students report to school as per normal from 29 September 2026 onwards.
P4	Students do not report to school from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. Instead, they will have Home-Based Learning from Thursday to Monday, 24 to 28 September 2026. There are no online face-to-face lessons but students will be assigned work to do independent study at home. Students report to school as per normal from 29 September 2026 onwards.
P5	Students report to school as per normal from 24 to 30 September 2026.

PSLE Marking Exercise from 12 to 14 October 2026

The PSLE Marking Exercise will take place from 12 to 14 October 2026. These 3 days are non-school days for P1 to P6 students. However, we will be having the following programmes. Notifications will be sent out via PG by end September:

- Support lessons for selected P3 and P5 students.
- Matatalab Coding Enrichment for interested P2 students on one of the days during the PSLE Marking Exercise.
