1. National Day Celebrations



The celebrations will take place on **Friday, 7 August**. On this day, the school will function from **7.30 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.** Our theme for this year's celebration is **"Majulah Singapura—Go Beyond!"**. This year marks Singapore's 61st year of independence as well as the 60th anniversary of the National Pledge (Pledge 60). What does the Pledge mean to us, and how can we live out the values in the Pledge in our daily actions? This is an opportune time for us to reflect on the significance of the Pledge and our shared national identity, and strengthen our collective commitment to the nation.

Students will have the opportunity to witness the Observance Ceremony taking place in the morning, participate in classroom activities and watch the National Day Concert. We look forward to celebrating this important day with our students and fostering in them a sense of national pride and unity! Please note that **Monday, 10 August**, is a school holiday. Hence, students will report back to school for lessons on **Tuesday, 11 August**.

2. PSLE Oral Examinations

The PSLE English and Mother Tongue Oral Examinations will take place nationwide on **12 August (Wednesday)** and **13 August (Thursday)**.

All Primary 1 to 5 students will not need to report to school for lessons on these two days.

3. Primary 6 Preliminary Listening Comprehension and Written Examinations

The Preliminary Listening Comprehension Examination will take place on **17 August**, while the Preliminary Written Examinations will be conducted **from 20 to 26 August**.

School will continue as usual for all Primary 1 to Primary 5 students. For Primary 6 students, parents/guardians are requested to refer to the Parents Gateway (PG) form issued on 23 July 2026 for details of the Preliminary Listening Comprehension and Written Examination arrangements.
