Dear Parents/ Guardians of Secondary One Students,

Welcome back to Term 3. I hope you and your child/ward spent quality time bonding over the Term 2 break. 1. Early Dismissal on 7 July 2026

The O-Level Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Listening Comprehension Examination will be conducted on Tuesday, 7 July 2026. To facilitate the conduct of the examinations, all students from Sec 1 to 5 will be dismissed at 12.15pm.

2. Home-Based Learning (HBL) days on 14, 15 and 16 July 2026

The N-Level and O-Level English Language and Mother Tongue Language Oral Examinations will be conducted throughout the day on 14, 15 and 16 July 2026. To facilitate the conduct of these examinations, the days will be designated as Home-Based Learning (HBL) days.

The remaining HBL days in Term 3 are 28 July and 28 August 2026.

All Secondary 1 to 5 students are not required to report to school on these days. Lesson instructions will be made available via the RSS HBL microsite.

3. Term 3 Weighted Assessment (31 July to 14 August 2026)

WA is part of continuous assessment of learning and will take place during time-tabled lesson time. Please refer to the attached for the WA3 schedule.

Students who are unwell and unable to take the WA must produce a medical certificate (MC) upon return to school. There will be no re-sitting of the paper for students and the WA will be given as a practice assignment.
