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ADDENDUM TO ADVISORY 04/2023 ON THE MINIMUM CLINICAL DATA REPORT TEMPLATE FOR DIABETIC RETINAL PHOTOGRAPHY (DRP) AND DIABETIC FOOT SCREENING (DFS), AND SHARING OF THE DRP TECHNICAL GUIDE

On 12 June 2023, MOH had issued an advisory on the minimum clinical data reporting template for diabetic retinal photography (DRP) and diabetic foot screening (DFS) and shared the DRP Technical Guide (Advisory No. 04/2023). Since then, there had been a few requests for clarifications and updates from stakeholders. We have reviewed these in conjunction with the relevant expert workgroups and updated the DRP Technical Guide in **Annex A**.

KEY UPDATES TO THE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DRP TECHNICAL GUIDE

2. Healthier SG (HSG) Care Reporting Fields for DRP. Taking into consideration further feedback from HSG Care Protocol Workgroup and Singapore Diabetic Retinal Photography (SiDRP) committee, we have revised the HSG care reporting fields for DRP to enable clearer coding of the DRP results. Please refer to **Table 4.1** for the revised fields which includes the severity of the non-proliferative retinopathy to be captured.
3. Update to Referral Criteria for Abnormal DRP. There are 2 key updates to the referral criteria for abnormal DRP. These will be implemented **by 1 Aug 2023**:
 - i. **Table 5.2**: Clarifications on the features graded in each severity level of Diabetic Retinopathy (DR) and the corresponding referral guidance.
 - ii. **Table 5.3**: Clarifications on the features and referral timeframe for Diabetic Maculopathy (DME).
4. Inclusion of Website Address to Access the DRP Technical Guide. To enable future updates to be easily accessible to providers and healthcare professionals, we will be uploading the DRP Technical Guide on AIC's Primary Care Pages, under the Healthier SG Care Protocol page for Diabetes (<https://www.primarycarepages.sg/healthier-sg/care-protocols/chronic-care-protocols/diabetes-mellitus>).
