Licensees of Acute Hospital Service and Community Hospital Service ("Licensees")

NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF LICENCE CONDITIONS UNDER THE HEALTHCARE SERVICES ACT (HCSA)

The Director-General of Health intends to issue additional conditions to your licence granted under the HCSA ("Licence") by imposing two (2) sets of licence conditions ("LCs") under Section 13(1) of the Healthcare Services Act 2020¹. The LCs are the LCs for Acute Hospital Service Licensees and LCs for Community Hospital Service Licensees which are applicable to Acute Hospital Service licensees and Community Hospital Service licensees respectively. Please refer to Annex A for the LCs applicable to the licensable healthcare services ("Services") you are providing and ensure that you and your personnel are familiar and comply with these LCs when providing the healthcare services. The full list of Licence Conditions can be found on https://www.moh.gov.sg/hcsa/resources.

2. These LCs will apply to all persons which have been licensed under the HCSA to provide the abovementioned Services, and are intended to provide further clarity on the requirements to ensure the safe and effective provision of Services by Licensees, including any specified services provided as part of the Service. All other conditions of your Licence that have been imposed before the date of this notification shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect (unless superseded), and these LCs shall be read and construed with the requirements stipulated in the HCSA and its Regulations [including but not limited to the Healthcare Services (General) Regulations 2021, the

^{13.—(1)} In granting a licence to any person or renewing any licence, the Director-General may impose any conditions that the Director-General considers requisite or expedient having regard to the purposes of this Act.

Healthcare Services (Advertisement) Regulations 2021] and the relevant Service Regulation(s).

- 3. In line with the launch of EatSafe Singapore on 6 Jul 2022 (see <u>Annex B</u>), the EatSafe standards, such as the implementation of the International Dysphagia Diet Standardisation Initiative ("IDDSI") framework², will be enforced from 1 July 2024 onwards.
- 4. A breach of the LCs may result in regulatory actions being taken against licensees under section 20 of the HCSA, including but not limited to
 - (a) suspension or revocation of the licensee's Licence;
 - (b) shortening the term of the licensee's Licence;
 - (c) a direction requiring the licensee to rectify the contravention, or prevent a recurrence of the contravention; and/or
 - (d) a direction requiring the licensee to pay a financial penalty.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 14(2) of the HCSA, you may submit written representations to the Director-General of Health with respect to the proposed Licence Conditions described above within 14 days (excluding the date of this notification) of this notification at <a href="https://hcsa.com/hcsa.
