## UPDATED MOH ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN HEALTHCARE GUIDELINES (AIHGle 2.0)

The Ministry of Health (MOH) and the Health Sciences Authority (HSA) co-developed and launched the revised Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare Guidelines (AIHGle 2.0) on 10 March 2026. We thank Synapxe, the Infocomm Media Development Authority, the Personal Data Protection Commission, the Academy of Medicine Singapore, College of Family Physicians Singapore, and various professional boards and associations, for their partnership in developing AIHGle 2.0.

2. Building on the 2021 framework, AIHGle 2.0 (refer to **Annex A**) addresses developments in AI, such as Generative AI, and clarifies that AI should augment and empower our healthcare professionals in enhancing healthcare delivery, with patients at the heart of it. The updated guidelines will enable healthcare institutions to build and implement clinically safe and effective AI solutions. It also complements [HSA's Regulatory Guidelines for Software as Medical Devices](#).

3. Key updates to AIHGle 2.0 include:

- i. Strengthening accountability through clarity of responsibilities for key stakeholders, including the developers, deployers, and users;
- ii. Improving trust via guidance on transparency to facilitate informed decision-making; and
- iii. Updated guidance on AI deployment, such as assessing and mitigating risks.

4. AIHGle 2.0 is complemented by a deployers' toolkit (refer to **Annex B**) to support new adopters with internal governance and selecting appropriate AI solutions and an infographic (refer to **Annex C**) summarising the roles and responsibilities for developers, deployers, and users.

5. AIHGle is a living document that will be periodically updated to provide appropriate guidance, considering developments and new technologies. The responsible development and deployment of AI in healthcare is a shared endeavour. Let us work together to enable safe and trusted AI across the healthcare ecosystem.
