2. UPCOMING EVENTS

2.1 P5 Internationalisation Trip to Bali, Indonesia

To develop students' regional and cultural awareness as part of the school's signature WorldClass@YN initiative, the school is organising an overseas immersion experience for selected Primary 5 students to Bali, Indonesia, from Sunday, 30 August 2026 to Tuesday, 1 September 2026.

The students will visit places of cultural significance, including the iconic rice terraces of Bali, where they will connect their experiences to their learning in P5 Project Work. They will also visit our partner school, Regents Primary School, Bali, following up on the cultural exchange that took place when they visited Yu Neng Primary last year. This visit will further strengthen cross-cultural understanding and collaboration between both schools. We hope that our students will gain meaningful insights from this experience and develop a deeper appreciation of the cultures and communities within our region.

2.2 Teachers' Day Celebrations 2026

As shared earlier in our August 2026 LTP, we will be celebrating Teachers' Day on **Thursday, 3 September 2026. School will end at 10.30am**, and students will be dismissed via the usual school gates. Kindly make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward at dismissal. Please note that students will not need to attend school from Friday, 4 September 2026. School will resume for all students on Monday, 14 September 2026, following the September holidays.

2.3 P6 Study Break

Aligned with MOE guidelines and in support of our Primary 6 students' well-being and readiness for the upcoming PSLE Written Examinations, a three-day study break will be implemented from **Monday, 21 September 2026 to Wednesday, 23 September 2026**.

During this period, P6 students will not be required to report to school and should stay at home to revise and consolidate their learning in preparation for the examinations. We encourage them to use this time meaningfully while also taking care of their well-being and getting sufficient rest. We wish all our Primary 6 students the very best for the PSLE.

2.4 Mid-Autumn Festival

As we look forward to our Mid-Autumn Festival celebrations on **Wednesday, 23 September 2026**, students will enjoy a week of enriching cultural experiences in the lead-up to the occasion, bringing its spirit and traditions to life.

Through pre-assembly programmes, cultural sharing and engaging Mid-Autumn-themed activities during recess, students will learn about the significance, customs and traditions of this special occasion. Our Mother Tongue Language teachers will also deepen students' understanding through the lessons planned, helping them connect language learning with culture and values. We hope these experiences will inspire our students to appreciate the richness of our cultural heritage and find joy in learning, sharing and celebrating together.

To support the conduct of the PSLE Written Papers, several of our teachers will be involved in invigilation duties. As such, Self-Directed Learning (SDL) Days have been scheduled for Primary 3 to Primary 5 students during this period. These SDL Days are designed to foster greater independence and self-management in learning. Students will be provided with meaningful learning tasks by their teachers to complete at home.
