2.3 Learning for Life Programme (LLP)

Our LLP nurtures students' leadership competencies and civic responsibility through meaningful community engagement. This term, our Primary 4 students will participate in Values-in-Action learning experiences by connecting with seniors at Active Ageing

Centres in our neighbourhood. Through scheduled visits, students will interact with and learn from elderly residents, fostering intergenerational bonds whilst developing empathy and communication skills. These experiences allow our students to put school values into practice and understand the importance of contributing to our community.

2.4 Applied Learning Programme (ALP)

Our ALP empowers Primary 5 students to tackle real-world sustainability challenges by applying knowledge across different subjects. Students will focus on energy conservation. Working collaboratively, students will develop innovative solutions to these environmental challenges. Through this hands-on experience, we aim to nurture environmentally conscious citizens who can think critically and contribute meaningfully to a sustainable future.

2.5 Internationalisation Programme

Our Internationalisation Programme cultivates cross-cultural literacy, enabling students to understand and appreciate diverse perspectives. This term, selected Primary 5 students will host a group of Hong Kong students in March, whilst another group will embark on an overseas learning journey to Hong Kong in May. These valuable experiences will allow our students to forge meaningful friendships, develop cultural sensitivity, and gain a broader global perspective through interactions with their peers from other countries.

2.6 Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) Open House

The CCA Open House will be held on **22 May 2026** for Primary 3 parents and students. The Open House is designed to help students discover their interests and talents whilst providing parents with insights into the diverse range of CCAs.

During the Open House, students will participate in hands-on activities and demonstrations, allowing them to experience different CCAs firsthand. They will have the opportunity to interact with CCA teachers and student leaders, ask questions, and gain an understanding of what each CCA involves.

We believe that this interactive approach will enable both you and your child to make well-informed decisions when selecting a CCA. Further details will be shared via Parents Gateway closer to the date.

3 PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS

3.1 Direct School Admission (DSA) Webinar

We will be conducting a Direct School Admission (DSA) briefing for Primary 5 and Primary 6 parents via a webinar on **Thursday, 2 April 2026** from **3.00 pm to 4.00 pm**.
