We welcome all our students back to school for Semester 2. At the same time, we would like to take this opportunity to update you on the following:

1. **Celebration of Term 2 Activities.** The school firmly believes in nurturing our students holistically with strong character and leadership qualities. We would like to share with you some key highlights in Term 2.

Student Development	On 24 April, the school was filled with excitement during Come as a Book Character Day as students dressed up as their favourite literary characters. Through storytelling sessions and interactive activities, students explored different book genres while developing creativity, communication, and collaboration skills. The event also fostered a stronger love for reading and a wonderful sense of community among students
	In May 2026, our students embarked on Overseas Learning Journeys to Brunei and Hong Kong, providing them with valuable opportunities to learn beyond the classroom and broaden their understanding of the world around them. A key milestone this year was our inaugural visit to Brunei, where our students visited Tumpuan Telisai Primary School. Organised in collaboration with Anglo-Chinese School (Junior), the programme also brought together students from both schools, providing additional opportunities for interaction, friendship, and shared learning. As the first Bendemeer Primary School delegation to visit Brunei, our students had the unique opportunity to experience a different culture, gain new perspectives, and build meaningful connections with their Bruneian peers. Our students also visited Yan Chai Hospital Choi Hin To Primary School in Hong Kong, strengthening our longstanding partnership and fostering friendships through shared learning experiences and cultural exchanges. These international learning experiences help our students develop global awareness, cross-cultural understanding, and confidence. Through meaningful interactions with peers from different backgrounds, they gain valuable perspectives and build connections that extend beyond the classroom.
	As part of the Hari Raya Festive Outreach on 25 March , our prefects, teachers and school leaders visited neighbourhood businesses around the school to spread festive cheer and appreciation. Handcrafted gifts were presented to business owners and residents as a gesture of gratitude and goodwill. Through these meaningful interactions, our students had the opportunity to connect with the community, put our ASPIRE values into action, and represent Bendemeer Primary School with warmth and pride
