

Clinical Preceptorship (CP) Course

Introduction

The course covers the concepts, principles, and practices of clinical preceptorship in nursing. It teaches effective mentoring and support to staff and nursing students, creating a positive learning environment, and exploring best practices for providing constructive feedback and promoting student engagement. Additionally, it delves into crucial ethical, legal, and professional issues while maintaining high standards of professionalism and ethical conduct

Aim

This course aims to prepare and develop nurses for their role in welcoming, integrating, supervising, facilitating and assessing nursing students to the team and place of work.
