

Clinical Assessor Workshop

Course Description:

Clinical assessors play an important role in ensuring quality clinical care are delivered by competent staff. A qualified clinical assessor conducts clinical supervision of ground nurses and provide clinical guidance when there is an identified gap in care delivery performance. The assessor workshop is structured to allow attendees to further understand the purpose of competency-based assessment. Attendees are exposed to assessment related matters such as interrater reliability, reassessment, handling weak performers and giving constructive feedback.

The workshop also introduces concepts on core and unit-based competencies and how competencies are identified as crucial to clinical practice, as well as how assessment outcomes are utilised as information source for identifying training needs and competency trends.
