

## Clinical Preceptorship (CP) Course

## Introduction

The course covers the concepts, principles, and practices of clinical preceptorship in nursing. It provides participants with the essential knowledge, skills and attitude for the role of a clinical preceptor for newly recruited nurses and nursing students from pre-registration or pre-enrolment courses.

#### Aim

This course aims to prepare and develop nurses for their role in welcoming, integrating, supervising, facilitating and assessing nursing students to the team and place of work.

- 1. Discuss the role and responsibilities of a clinical preceptor
- 2. Describe the adult learning approach
- 3. Communicate, supportive and giving feedback
- 4. Act as professional role models in clinical practice
