

Life Support Course for Nurses

Programme Overview

The **Life Support Course for Nurses (LSCN)** is a blended learning programme designed to prepare Registered Nurses to function as competent first responders in cardiac arrest situations within hospital settings. The course integrates theory and hands-on practice through simulated resuscitation scenarios

Aim

To bridge the gap between **Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS)** and **Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)** by equipping nurses with essential knowledge, psychomotor skills, and leadership capabilities for effective resuscitation

Course Structure

- Total duration: **15 hours**
- Mode of delivery: **Blended learning** (online lectures and hands-on practical sessions)
- Key components: Airway management, defibrillation, and megacode simulations
