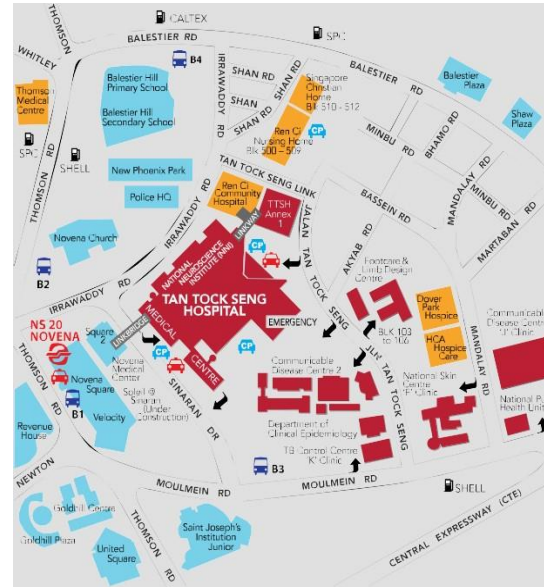

Aim

The course aim to equip the registered nurse with knowledge and skills to perform male catheterization

Learning Objective

Upon completion of this programme, the participants will be able to:

1. apply the understanding on the anatomy and physiology of the urinary system when performing male catheterisation
2. apply understanding of legal aspect and ethical principles when performing male urethra catheterisation
3. select appropriate type and size of urinary catheter in accordance to the patient's condition
4. explain the contraindications and problems associated with Male urinary catheterization;
5. demonstrate competence to perform male urethra catheterisation and reflect on skill performance

Learning Contents

1. Organization policies and procedural guidelines
2. Legal and ethical concepts (accountability of RNs; responsibilities of the RNs during situations where patients develop complications and problems arising from performing male catheterization)
3. Implement prevention strategies and patient/caregiver education
4. Performing male catheterisation on manikin, each participants return demo on manikin
5. Competency assessment will perform on patients in clinical setting
