Course Overview

The Clinical Instructor course is intended for Registered Nurses who work primarily in a clinical setting and are interested in developing their supervision, coaching and clinical teaching skills.

Course Objectives

- Discuss the roles and responsibilities of a clinical instructor in relation to conducting clinical teaching supervision, assessment, evaluation and providing feedback.
- Select and utilize various learning styles to implement strategies that accommodate learners' needs.
- Exhibit the correct communication techniques to express himself/herself when relating to learners.
- Approach the cultural differences of learners with sensitivity and respect.
- Collaborate with learners to develop their learning goals, objectives, learning styles, performance and progress inclusive of documentation.
