

Clinical Preceptorship Course

Course Description:

The Clinical Preceptorship Course aims to empower nurses with the requisite knowledge, skills, and attitude for conducting effective clinical teaching and supervision of pre-registration/pre-enrolment nursing students. It uses blended learning to prepare the competent clinical nurse to understand the roles and responsibilities of clinical preceptors (CP), develop clinical supervision and assessment skills and the use of constructive feedback. There will be case discussions on challenging learners and the use of learning contract to enhance their preparedness of the role. The teaching strategies include through didactic lectures, group discussions, case discussions, role plays, and eLearning. Finally, the participants will be assessed via the Preceptor Evaluation Checklist.

Course Content:

1. Principles & best practices in clinical supervision and assessment
2. Principles of preceptorship: roles and responsibilities of a clinical preceptor
3. Adult learning principles and learning styles
4. Effective communication skills and giving feedback
5. Evaluation of clinical education and learning environment

Target learners:

Nurses, RNs and Ens, with at least 2 years of clinical experience and are deemed competent in clinical practice.
