

Pharmacology for Nurses

Course Description:

The basic pharmacology workshop includes fundamentals concepts such as pharmacokinetics, pharmacodynamics and drugs for common clinical conditions (cardiology, diabetes mellitus, drugs for post-op management, clinical infections, Parkinson, epilepsy, antidepressant medications) and nurses' roles during the administration of medications.

Learning Outcomes:

- Perform nursing role in medication administration and patient education in acute setting
- List preventive measures of medication errors
- Employ critical thinking skills to enhance safe medication administration
- Predict potential drug-drug interactions and drug-food interactions based on physiologic responses to pharmacological agents and apply critical thinking skills for appropriate intervention
- Identify pharmacokinetic/pharmacodynamic effects for different patient population
- Nurture effective communication between healthcare professionals to enhance medication safety for better patient outcomes
- Empower patients with proper education on the pharmacological treatment received
