Course Overview

This 64-hour certificate course offers a rigorous and comprehensive curriculum across 6 modules, each addressing critical aspects of infection control tailored to community care settings:

- ICC 301: Infection Prevention and Control Precautions
- 2. ICC 302: Environment and Facilities Management
- 3. ICC 303: Care of Devices
- 4. **ICC 304:** Regional Infectious Diseases and Multi-Drug-Resistant Organisms
- 5. ICC 305: Surveillance and Outbreak Management
- 6. ICC 306: Governance and Management

To equip registered nurses to lead infection control programs by implementing advanced prevention measures, managing outbreaks, and developing proactive, comprehensive infection control plans.
