

BASIC DERMATOLOGY NURSING COURSE FOR NURSES AT INTERMEDIATE LONG-TERM CARE (ILTC)

Overview

The Basic Dermatology Nursing Course for Nurses at ILTC seeks to empower nurses with essential knowledge, skills, and attitudes to provide safe and competent care to residents.

Target Audience

This course is targeted at nurses who meet any of the following criteria:

1. Lack prior knowledge and skills of dermatology nursing.
2. Require some form of refresher or re-assessment of clinical competency.
3. Whose nursing scope involves the management of patients with skin conditions.

3. Lectures, video demonstrations, practicum, and case discussions

There will be a Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) session at the end of the training & onsite competencies assessment tests.
