

## Care of Patient with inserted lines and drains

### Course Description:

This is a fully integrated workshop focusing on devices that can be inserted in patients. The aim of workshop is to equip nurses with skills to identify, administer protocol-based treatment and evaluate patients' clinical conditions, acting according to the devices inserted. Instructional strategy utilized for the workshop is PBL with clinical cases to stimulate systematic approach to recognition, assessment, intervention and evaluation of patient's clinical conditions and treatment. Participants are expected to relate clinical information such as physical assessment, clinical equipment management, electrolytes evaluation and vital signs towards justification for the inserted lines and devices. Nurses will work with the medical team in providing necessary care and support for patients under their care.

- Group presentations on PBL cases
