SUBJECT	EXAM FORMAT
ENGLISH LANGUAGE	Paper 1: Writing (1 hour 50 minutes) <u>Section A: Editing (10 marks)</u> Candidates to identify and edit grammatical errors in a short written text. <u>Section B: Situational Writing (30 marks)</u> Candidates write 200-250 words on a given situation which will involve viewing of a visual text. <u>Section C: Continuous Writing (30 marks)</u> Candidates write 220–300 words on one of four topics set.
	Paper 2: Comprehension (1 hour 50 minutes) <u>Section A: Visual Text Comprehension (5 marks)</u> Candidates respond to questions based on Texts 1 and 2, one of which is a visual text. <u>Section B: Narrative Comprehension (20 marks)</u> Candidates respond to a variety of questions based on Text 3 which is a narrative or a recount. <u>Section C: Non-Narrative Comprehension (25 marks)</u> Candidates respond to a variety of questions based on Text 4, a non-narrative text, and write an 80-word response to a summary writing task.
	Paper 3: Listening (About 45 minutes) <u>Section A (22 marks)</u> Candidates respond to a variety of listening tasks based on a number of audio recordings, which the candidates will hear twice. <u>Section B (8 marks)</u> Candidates listen to an audio recording and do a note-taking exercise. Candidates will hear the recording only once. This component was conducted in Term 3.
	Paper 4: Oral Communication The two parts in this paper are thematically linked. <u>Part 1: Planned Response (15 marks)</u> Candidates plan and deliver a response of up to 2 minutes to a video clip and accompanying prompt presented on a computer screen. <u>Part 2: Spoken Interaction (15 marks)</u> Candidates engage in a discussion with the Examiners on a topic broadly related to the video clip used in Part 1. This component was conducted in Term 2.

- **第六部分：阅读理解二 (Comprehension (Open Ended)) (20分)**
 - 考生根据所提供的1篇短文的内容回答问题。
