

IMPORTANT: Please read through before proceeding to login instructions

Mandatory Login Via Singpass 2FA

1. Singpass 2-Step Verification (2FA) login to Singapore Nursing Board (SNB) account has been made mandatory from **15 January 2017**. To check if you are eligible for Singpass, please refer to Singpass FAQ page (<https://ask.gov.sg/singpass>).
2. You will be required to set up the 2FA for your Singpass login before you can access your SNB account. Please refer to Singpass website (<https://portal.singpass.gov.sg/home/ui/support>) for more information on Singpass 2FA login.
3. Nurses/ Midwives who are not eligible for Singpass and are not practising as a nurse/ midwife **in Singapore** will not be able to access their SNB account online. For further enquiries, please contact SNB via email at SNB@spb.gov.sg.







Step 3: Click “For Individual Users” logo






